Monday
30 June 2025

President Joseph Aoun contacted Lama Al Amin after racist encounter in the airport

After being subjected to a racist [incident](#) at the Rafik Hariri International airport, Lebanese citizen Lama Al Amin received a call from President Joseph Aoun to express his regrets following the incident on Monday, June 30.

The President assured Al Amin that this matter will be “extended to all public institutions” and that “further measures will be taken”.

Simultaneously, the General Directorate of General Security [announced](#) that it took the “appropriate disciplinary action” against the offending officer.

Tuesday
1 July 2025

Two citizens injured in Israeli airstrike on Jabal al-Ahmar road

An Israeli airstrike targeted an uninhabited house in Jabal al-Ahmar area between Shukin and Harouf, injuring two citizens including a child in the early morning hours of Tuesday, July 1 according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli combing operation in Aita al-Shaab and Adaisseh

Israeli forces conducted combing operations using machine guns toward the Adaisseh neighborhood and Khallet Wardeh in Aita al-Shaab on Tuesday, July 1.

Simultaneously, Israeli drones dropped [soundbombs](#) near a pickup truck in Kfarkila and no injuries were reported.

League of Public Administration announces strike against wage inequality

In a Facebook statement published on Tuesday, July 1, the League of Public Administration announced a general [strike](#) within public administrations “and a complete cessation of duties” on July 2, 3, and 4.

The statement noted that the movement will expand to indefinite work stoppage until full rights are achieved.

Wednesday
2 July 2025

[Large fires in Zgharta waste landfill](#)

A large [fire](#) broke out in a waste landfill in Bchenine, Zgharta, and is continuing on Wednesday, July 2, caused by the accumulated waste over the years. Cases of suffocations have been recorded.

[Israeli soundbombs and combing operations in the South](#)

An Israeli plane dropped soundbombs on a house in [Aita al-Shaab](#) and near a farmer in Yarin without injuries on Wednesday, July 2.

Israeli forces combed the outskirts of Khiam with machine guns.

[Minister of Environment files a complaint concerning Qobayat fires](#)

Minister of Environment Tamara Al Zein filed a complaint at the Ministry of Justice against anyone suspected as a perpetrator, instigator, or accomplice, for the Qobayat forests' fire in Akkar, on Wednesday, July 2, according to the National News Agency.

Thursday
3 July 2025

[One killed and five injured in Israeli bombing on Khaldeh](#)

An Israeli drone launched two missiles on a car in Khaldeh on the afternoon of Thursday, July 3, killing the driver of the car and injuring 5 others.

[Multiple Israeli airstrikes in border villages and Bekaa](#)

In one of its heaviest attacks, a series of raids targeted al-Wardieh and Mahmoudiya near al-Aishiyeh and al-Jarmak in Jezzine, three raids in [Hama Zalaya](#) in the Western Bekaa, and other raids between Yahmar al-Shaqif and Deir Siryan in Marjeyoun on Thursday, July 3.

Simultaneously, Israeli forces bombed a house on the outskirts of [Kfarkila](#) and dropped a soundbomb towards Aita al-Shaab with no injuries recorded.

Friday
4 July 2025

[Israeli forces conduct detonation operations in the South](#)

Israeli forces detonated a bulldozer on the road between Mays al-Jabal and Houola, and a linen factory in Mays al-Jabal that had been [destroyed](#) and rebuilt after the war on Friday, July 4.

Simultaneously, Israeli forces targeted a house near Tallet Shawat in [Aita al-Shaab](#).

Saturday and Sunday
5 and 6 July
2025

One killed and five injured in Israeli airstrikes on the South

One citizen was killed and two others were injured after an Israeli airstrike attacked a car near a roundabout in Bint Jbeil on Saturday, June 5. Two other citizens were injured in another car raid in [Shagra](#), and another raid on a house in Shebaa also injured a person.

Simultaneously, Israeli forces combed the outskirts of [Khiam](#) with machine guns.

Heavy Israeli airstrikes on Bekaa and the South; combing operation in Kfarkila

In a heavy night attack, three Israeli raids targeted the outskirts of Bouday and another one on the Flawi Heights, west of [Baalbek](#) on Sunday, June 6. Other airstrikes attacked Arzi and Burj Rahal towns in [Saida](#), Raddi and Matariyeh near the Litani River, Iqlim al-Tuffah, Kfarmelki, and Wadi al-Zarariyeh.

Simultaneously, soundbombs were thrown by Israeli jets on Maroun el-Rass and [Kfarkila](#). A combing operation was also conducted in Kfarkila and Marjeyoun plain was attacked by machine guns from Israeli forces [stationed](#) in Tallet al-Hamames.

REPORTING A VIOLATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS TO CLDH

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:

- **WHERE:** City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. what prison)
- **WHAT:** Nature of the violation
- **HOW:** A narrative description of what happened
- **WHEN:** Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)
- **TO WHOM:** Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.
- **WHO** is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
