Monday 6
April 2026

Casualties reported in Ain Saadeh, Kfarreman, and Beirut

An Israeli airstrike on Ain Saadeh resulted in three fatalities, including two women, and three women injured. In Mifdoun, a strike on a truck caused four injuries on Monday, April 6. In Hammadiyah Tyre, a drone strike killed one person, while in Kfarreman a strike on a vehicle killed four people. In Toul, an airstrike killed a couple and injured their two children, aged 9 and 15. In Jnah, a strike killed five people, including a 15-year-old girl, and injured 52 others, including eight children.

Israeli airstrikes and shelling escalate across Yanooh, Toul, and Tyre

Israeli airstrikes struck Mifdoun, Barish, Tayr Debba, Tuffahata, al-Samaaiyeh, a house in al-Hanniyeh, al-Sireh, al-Zrariyeh, Kounine, the outskirts of Yanooh, al-Bazourieh, Siddiqine on Monday, April 6. A residential building was also struck in al-Dweir, al-Jmeijmeh, Majdal Selm, Zbdine, Hannawe, Majdal Zoun, Bint Jbeil, Deir al-Zahrani, Kfarreman, Bafliyeh, Toul, Yahmar al-Shaqif, and the outskirts of Nabatieh al-Fawqa.

Additional strikes targeted motorcycles on the Hammadiyah road in Tyre, alongside ongoing demolitions of homes and religious sites in border villages.

Artillery shelling targeted Kounine, the outskirts of Yanooh and Wadi Jilo, Bayout al-Siyad, and al-Mansouri.

Tuesday 7
April 2026

Airstrikes and demolitions reported across Qana, Majdal Zoun, and al-Taybeh

Israeli airstrikes struck al-Ramadiyah, areas between Qana and Hannawe, Kafra, Siddiqine, al-Tayri, al-Mansouri, al-Zrariyeh, Zawtar al-Sharqiyeh, the outskirts of al-Abbassiyeh, areas between Haris and Haddatha, Bricheaa, areas between al-Bazourieh and Wadi Jilo, Majdal Zoun, Tebnine, al-Housh, and Kfardounin on Tuesday, April 7. Homes were demolished in Aita al-Shaab alongside a large explosion near al-Taybeh.

Artillery and phosphorus shelling targeted Braachit, al-Mansouri, al-Ramadiyah, Jbal al-Botm, and Majdal Zoun.

Wednesday
8 April 2026

Casualties reported across Lebanon amid ongoing escalation

Israeli airstrikes across multiple Lebanese regions, including Beirut, resulted in a revised non-final toll of 182 killed and 890 injured, bringing the cumulative death toll since March 2 to 1,739 and the number of injured to 5,873.

In Saida, an initial toll recorded eight fatalities and 22 injuries following an Israeli airstrike in the south of Lebanon.

Airstrikes hit Beirut, Baalbek, and southern towns amid ongoing escalation

Israeli airstrikes struck Majdal Selm, the Talet al-Khayyat area in Beirut, al-Qleileh, Deir Qanoun al-Nahr, Tyre, Douris, the Ansariyeh–Sarafand highway, Zahr al-Sarafand, Tabna, al-Bissariyeh, Arki, al-Rawda, Shmistar, Barbour, Corniche al-Mazraa, Ain al-Mreisseh, Burj Abi Haidar, areas in Yahmar, Mashghara, and al-Rihan on Wednesday, April 8.

Additional drone strikes targeted a motorcycle in al-Shahabiyeh and a vehicle on the Siddiqine road.

Artillery shelling and machine-gun fire targeted al-Khiyam, Kafra, and Majdal Selm, alongside continued sweeping fire across multiple areas.

Thursday 9
April 2026

Airstrikes and heavy fire reported across Nabatieh, Jwaya, and Burj Qalaway areas

Israeli airstrikes struck the outskirts of al-Babliyah, Debbine, al-Khiyam, Nabatieh al-Fawqa, Batouliyah, Kafra, Bint Jbeil, Harouf, al-Shahabiyeh, al-Saksakiyeh, Toulina, Burj Qalaway, Jwaya, Bricheaa, al-Qasmiyeh, the outskirts of al-Kharaeb, Adloun, Khirbet Selm, al-Sharqiyeh, Zawtar, al-Dweir, Jibchit, and Kounine on Thursday, April 9.

Artillery shelling and machine-gun fire targeted al-Khiyam, Saf al-Hawa, al-Bouayda outskirts, al-Mansouri, Bayout al-Siyad, and al-Bayyada toward southern Tyre, alongside intermittent shelling across multiple areas.

UNICEF signals the impacts of the war in Lebanon on Children

Statement issued by the United Nations Children's Fund Lebanon on Thursday, April 9:

The intensification of hostilities in Lebanon continues to exact a devastating and inhumane toll on children. In just minutes yesterday, as news of a regional ceasefire agreement briefly ignited hope across the country, deadly Israeli airstrikes struck across Lebanon, reportedly killing 33 children and injuring 153.

Children and families faced a wave of bombardments that tore through communities with devastating impact. The latest bloodshed adds to a staggering 600 children either killed or injured in Lebanon since 2 March.

UNICEF is receiving reports of children being pulled from under the rubble, while others remain missing and separated from their families. Many are experiencing trauma, having lost loved ones, their homes, and any sense of safety. Across the country, more than one million people have been uprooted, including an estimated 390,000 children, many for the second, third, or even fourth time.

Friday 10
April 2026

Airstrikes and demolitions reported across Tyre, al-Khiyam, and Jezzine areas

Israeli airstrikes struck Deir Kifa, Srifa, Mahmoudiyeh near Aishiyeh, Ansar al-Bekaa, Beit Yahoun, Bint Jbeil, al-Mansouri, the outskirts of al-Majadel, Ras al-Ain, al-Samaaiyeh, Debbine, al-Shahabiyeh, and Jwaya on Friday, April 10.

Additional strikes targeted a position of the Islamic Health Authority in Srifa, while ambulances and rescue vehicles were hit in Deir Qanoun. Explosions and demolitions of homes were reported in al-Khiyam, Hanine, and Aita al-Shaab.

Artillery shelling targeted Bint Jbeil, villages across Tyre, and the heights of al-Rihan in Jezzine, alongside continued shelling across multiple areas.

Saturday & Sunday
11 & 12
April 2026

Casualties reported in Toul, Zefta, Kfar Sir, and Tuffahata

An Israeli airstrike on Toul in the Nabatieh district resulted in three fatalities, including a member of the health authority, and three injuries, including a paramedic on Saturday, April 11.

In Zefta, three people were killed, including a member of the Lebanese Civil Defense, and two others were injured.

In Kfar Sir, four people were killed, including a paramedic from the health authority, and four others were injured. In Tuffahata, an Israeli airstrike caused eight fatalities and nine injuries, including five in critical condition.

Airstrikes escalate across Tebnine, Aitit, and Markaba areas

Israeli airstrikes struck Khirbet Selm, Kounine, al-Zrariyeh, Dbaal, Kfartabnit, Srifa, Siddiqine, Tebnine, Debbine, al-Kfour, Zawtar al-Gharbiyeh, al-Majadel, Bint Jbeil, Burj Qalaway, Majdal Zoun, areas around Kfarreman, the outskirts of Shebaa, al-Mansouri, areas between al-Bazourieh and Aitit on Saturday, April 11.

Additional drone strikes targeted al-Majadel, while repeated raids hit Tebnine and Debbine, and a large explosion was reported near Markaba–Bani Hayan. Helicopter gunfire was also directed toward al-Khiyam.

Artillery and phosphorus shelling targeted al-Mansouri and Shamaa, while four shells fell between homes in areas between Jdeidet Marjayoun and Debbine without causing injuries.

Casualties reported in Qana and al-Bazourieh

An Israeli airstrike on Qana in the Tyre district resulted in five fatalities, including three women, and 25 injuries, on Sunday, April 12. In al-Bazourieh, Israeli airstrikes caused 18 injuries, including three in critical condition.

Airstrikes intensify across Tyre, Nabatieh, and western Bekaa

Israeli airstrikes struck al-Bazourieh, Yahmar al-Shaqif, Srafa, Shaqra, Aaramta, al-Mansouri, Kfartabnit, Mashghara, Siddiqine, al-Zrariyeh, areas between al-Habbariyeh and Shebaa, al-Qleileh, Bafliyeh, and Qlaouiyeh on Sunday, April 12.

Artillery and phosphorus shelling targeted al-Qasmiyeh, al-Kharaeb, Tayr Debba, al-Rashidiyeh, al-Abbassiyeh, the outskirts of al-Bazourieh, and multiple towns in Bint Jbeil district.

WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details
(e.g. which prison)



HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



WHAT:

Nature of the violation



WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
