Monday 9
March 2026

Multiple people killed and injured in southern Lebanon by Israeli airstrikes

Israeli airstrikes and artillery on Monday, March 9, killed two people and injured four others in Tebnine, and killed two and injured eight in Beit Lif. A separate airstrike on Shoukin killed one and injured eight, while artillery shelling in al-Qleileh killed a parish priest and injured six.

In al-Namiriyah, seven people were killed and two injured. In Tyirdba and Jwaya, initial reports indicated three killed and 15 injured in Tyirdba, while the final toll reached nine dead and 17 injured in Tyirdba, and seven dead and 23 injured in Jwaya, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes and drone attacks target southern Lebanon and border areas

Israeli airstrikes struck al-Ansariyah with two raids and additional strikes on Majdal Zoun, al-Bayyada, Kounine, Srifa, Yater, Hermel, Beit Leef and the outskirts of al-Mansouri on Monday, March 9.

Artillery shelling hit the Hamoul area, while drone strikes targeted Tebnine, an open area and a vehicle in Arab Salim–Habboush road. A drone also crashed in al-Bireh in Akkar without causing injuries.

Tuesday 10
March 2026

Four people killed and two injured in Hannawe and Ouzai

Israeli airstrikes on Tuesday, March 10, killed three people, including a paramedic, in Hannawe, while two others were injured in an initial strike. Another airstrike on a motorcycle in Ouzai killed one person, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes and shelling target southern Lebanon and Beirut suburbs

Israeli airstrikes struck al-Ansariyeh, Jwaya, Adchit, Beit Lif, and areas between Kafreman and Habboush on Tuesday, March 10. Additional strikes targeted Laylaki in Beirut's southern suburbs, al-Qleileh, Siddiqine, and al-Abbassiyeh, while a drone hit a motorcycle in Ouzai.

Artillery shelling struck Aita al-Shaab, Ramieh, and Yaroun, and a rocket fell behind a station in Bourj al-Moulouk, causing a fire.

Wednesday
11 March 2026

Tens of people killed and injured in Lebanon by Israeli airstrikes

Israeli airstrikes on Wednesday, March 11, killed eight people and injured three in Sha'th, while four were killed and nine injured in Burj al-Shamali. In Deir Antar, two were killed and six injured, and eight people were killed in Tebnine. In al-Shahabiyeh, seven were killed and 11 injured, while in Tamenin al-Tahta seven were killed and 18 injured, and five were injured in Ali al-Nahri.

Additional strikes injured four people in Aisha Bakkar and four in Tebnine, while five were killed and five injured in Qana, one was killed and eight injured in al-Housh, and one person was killed and two injured in Qalaouiyeh, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes and artillery shelling target Tyre, Bint Jbeil, and Nabatieh districts

Israeli airstrikes struck al-Khiyam, Tebnine, Bint Jbeil, al-Zrariyeh, and Burj Qalaway on Wednesday, March 11, alongside additional strikes on Humin al-Tahta, al-Marwaniyeh, and the outskirts of al-Smaaiyeh and Deir Antar. Airstrikes also targeted al-Sultaniyah, al-Naqoura, al-Taybeh, and Kfardounin at dawn, while a strike destroyed a building near al-Kfour roundabout and another hit the Maarka junction near Jabal Amel Hospital in al-Bass.

Artillery shelling targeted Wadi al-Slouqi, and Wadi al-Hujeir with heavy shelling reported in Tyre. A drone strike also targeted a vehicle in Saf al-Hawa in Bint Jbeil, alongside reported ground incursions in western and central sectors.

Thursday 12
January 2026

Dozens killed and injured in Lebanon as Israeli airstrikes hit multiple towns

Israeli airstrikes on Thursday, March 12, killed three people in Ain Ebel and three in Barish, while strikes on Arki initially killed nine, including five children, and injured seven. Additional strikes hit the Lebanese University in Hadath, killing two, and in Aramoun, five were killed and seven injured.

In Ramlet al-Bayda, the death toll rose to eight with 31 injured, while an initial strike had reported seven killed and 21 injured, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes and heavy shelling target Nabatieh, Tyre, and Baalbek districts

Israeli airstrikes struck Tyreflsiyeh, al-Qleileh, Kounine, Adchit, Tafahata, Kawthariyet al-Siyad, and al-Hanniyeh on Thursday, March 12. Additional strikes targeted al-Dweir, Abbassiyeh, and Ansar, with several injuries reported in Aabba, while further airstrikes hit Maarka junction and areas in Zoqaq al-Blat and al-Bashoura, partially destroying a previously threatened building.

Heavy artillery shelling targeted the outskirts of al-Qawzah, Ramieh, and Zawtar al-Sharqiyyeh, while an intense fire belt struck the surroundings of Wadi al-Slouqi towards Qabrikha and Majdal Selm. Additional airstrikes targeted Arid Dbine, al-Taybeh, and Ain Bourday near Douris, alongside a warning strike in Laylaki.

Friday 13
March 2026

Israeli airstrikes cause multiple fatalities and injuries in Nabatieh and Sidon

Israeli airstrikes on Friday, March 13, killed five people and injured five in Hay al-Rahibat in Nabatieh, with rescue operations ongoing due to missing persons under rubble. Additional strikes in Alfawwar, Saida district, killed eight and injured nine, while a separate strike targeting a car in Jnah killed one, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes and shelling target Nabatieh, Tyre, and southern suburbs of Beirut

Israeli airstrikes struck al-Khiyam, al-Kharaeb, Bint Jbeil, Deir Qanoun Ras al-Ain, al-Majadel, and the al-Jamous area in Beirut's southern suburbs on Friday, March 13. Additional strikes targeted Nabatieh city, including Hay al-Rahibat, alongside consecutive raids on Sajd in Iqlim al-Tuffah and further airstrikes on Jibchit, Yater, and al-Sultaniyah, causing injuries and significant damage.

Artillery shelling targeted the outskirts of Kfarhamam and al-Habbariyeh, while drone strikes targeted a motorcycle in Aitit and areas in al-Qleileh, where four individuals were reported trapped under rubble following early morning strikes. A drone strike also targeted an ambulance on the Tyreflsiyeh bridge without reported injuries, while Israeli shells fell inside a UNIFIL base in Mays al-Jabal.

Saturday & Sunday

March 2026

Airstrikes in Nabatieh and Beirut suburbs leave several dead and injured

Israeli airstrikes on Saturday, March 14, killed four people, including a child, and injured five in Mifdoun, while strikes in Majdal Selm killed one and injured two. A separate early morning strike on an apartment in Nabaa – Bourj Hammoud killed one and injured four, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes and artillery shelling target Marjayoun, Tyre, and Beirut suburbs

Israeli airstrikes struck Yater, Sajd in Iqlim al-Tuffah, Majdal Zoun, and the Taybeh area in Marjayoun on Saturday, March 14, with additional strikes on Blat (Haret al-Tahta) and Nabaa in Bourj Hammoud. Further airstrikes targeted Beirut's southern suburbs, while artillery shelling hit the outskirts of Aita al-Shaab and al-Qawzah, as well as al-Taybeh, Yahmar al-Shaqif, and al-Khiyam.

Additional shelling targeted the area between al-Qleileh, al-Hanniyeh, and al-Naqoura, while early morning strikes and shelling hit al-Taybeh, Wadi al-Slouqi, and the surroundings of Qabrikha and Touline.

Ministry of Health denounces Israeli claims of military purposes for ambulances

Statement issued by the Media Office of the Ministry of Public Health on Saturday, March 14:

Since the beginning of its aggression against Lebanon, the Israeli enemy has consistently targeted ambulance crews while they were performing their rescue duties on the front lines. This aggression culminated in the targeting of the primary healthcare center in the town of Burj Qalawiya, which is part of a network of centers spread across various Lebanese regions and operating in coordination with NGOs under the supervision of the Ministry of Public Health. This makes the attack an unequivocal targeting of a Lebanese civilian healthcare facility.

The attack killed the entire staff working at the center, including doctors, paramedics, and nurses. Only one healthcare worker survived, sustaining serious injuries, while 12 others were killed. The search continues for four missing individuals.

The total number of paramedics killed since March 2nd, reaching 26 martyrs and 51 wounded, is the most compelling evidence of the enemy's violent practices, a pattern that has continued since the previous round of war. This pattern is now even more violent and comprehensive, having expanded its targets to include the Lebanese Red Cross for the first time since October 2023.

Israeli airstrikes leave dozens dead and injured across southern Lebanon

Israeli airstrikes on Sunday, March 15, killed five people and injured six in Al-Qatrani, and killed two and injured four in Majdal Selm. Strikes in Aitit killed three and injured three, while in Hay al-Rahibat in Nabatieh, seven were killed, including four children, and five injured.

Additional strikes caused two injuries in Nabatieh, two in Yater, three in Majdal Zoun, and one in Mifdoun. In Sharhabil, Saida, one person was killed and three children injured, while a morning strike in Hay Saida killed four and injured two, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes and heavy shelling target Nabatieh, Tyre, and Jezzine districts

Israeli airstrikes struck al-Khiyam, al-Taybeh, Hanine, Kafra, al-Kfour, Toul, and al-Sharqiyeh in Nabatieh on Sunday, March 15. Additional strikes targeted al-Qantara, Qadmous, and Sinay, alongside airstrikes on al-Shabriha in Tyre, al-Qleileh, and the Jabal al-Rafi' area on the outskirts of Arab Salim. Two airstrikes also targeted the Jbour hills in Kfarhouna (Jezzine), while heavy and concentrated artillery shelling struck Zawtar al-Sharqiyeh.

WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details
(e.g. which prison)



HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



WHAT:

Nature of the violation



WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
