Monday
June 29 2026

Israeli Strikes and Military Activity Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Monday, June 29th, airstrikes, artillery shelling, and demolitions across southern Lebanon. Heavy artillery targeted the outskirts of Deir Siryan toward the Litani River banks, and an airstrike hit the area between al-Qantara and Deir Siryan. Israeli forces detonated residential buildings overnight in Taybeh and Hadatha. Sound bombs were dropped near civilians in Burj Qallawiyah and Baraachit, and a drone dropped a stun grenade near the Ghassan Daher Quarry on the Ibl al-Saqi road. Israeli forces continued to prevent residents of Majdal Zoun from returning to their homes; the town remains largely deserted. Homes in Majdal Zoun and Mansouri sustained damage from Israeli explosions carried out the previous evening. Artillery also struck Hadatha in the Bint Jbeil district.

Israeli Forces Burn Homes and Carry Out Demolitions Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces burned homes, on Tuesday, June 30th, in the towns of Ayta al-Jabal and Beit Yahoun in the Bint Jbeil district, and carried out a demolition operation in Markaba on the Marj road in the Marjayoun district. A drone dropped a sound bomb on a house in Hadatha with no injuries, and a second sound bomb on the eastern side of Braasheet. Israeli warplanes carried out a pre-dawn airstrike on Deir Siryan.

Parliamentary Committee Discusses Prison Conditions

Lebanon's parliamentary Administration and Justice Committee convened, on Tuesday, June 30th, to discuss conditions in Lebanese prisons and detention centers, in the presence of the Public Prosecutor, a representative of the Supreme Judicial Council, the Interior Ministry, and the Gendarmerie command. Committee chairman MP Georges Adwan stated that the session addressed delays in detention and trials, and announced the committee's intention to work toward a comprehensive reform package involving the judiciary, the Interior Ministry, the Justice Ministry, and the Supreme Judicial Council.

Israeli Strikes and Military Activity Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Wednesday, July 1st, drone strikes and artillery shelling across southern Lebanon, targeting Nabatieh al-Fawqa and Beit Yahoun, among others. Artillery shelled the outskirts of Beit Yahoun, accompanied by sweeping operations toward the eastern neighborhood in the direction of Hadatha. A drone struck a parked car in the al-Deir neighborhood of Nabatieh al-Fawqa.

Lebanese Army Engineering Regiment Removes Unexploded Rocket from Burj Rahal

The Lebanese Army's engineering regiment removed, on Wednesday, July 1st, an unexploded rocket left over from the war in the town of Burj Rahal in the Tyre district, escorted by the Burj Rahal municipality. The municipality urged residents not to approach suspicious objects or war remnants and to report them immediately to the relevant authorities.

Thursday
July 2 2026

Man Arrested for Assault on Wife in Chtaura Restaurant

Lebanese Internal Security Forces arrested, on Thursday, July 2nd, a man identified as T.M. (born 1992, Lebanese) after a video circulated on social media showing him assaulting his wife inside a restaurant in Chtaura. He was located and arrested at a hotel in Jounieh and referred to the competent judiciary.

Israeli Strikes, Demolitions, and Military Activity Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Thursday, July 2nd, airstrikes, demolitions, and drone strikes across southern Lebanon. A violent demolition operation targeted homes in Hadatha, with explosions heard across neighboring villages in the Bint Jbeil area. A large explosion was carried out in the vicinity of Kounine and al-Tairi in the Bint Jbeil district. Israeli warplanes struck Braasheet and the valley between Braasheet and Shaqra, and an explosion was heard in the Braasheet–Beit Yahoun area. A drone struck the vicinity of Ghandour Hospital in Nabatieh al-Fawqa twice within less than half an hour.

Friday
July 3 2026

Israeli Strikes and Military Activity Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Friday, July 3rd, drone strikes and demolitions across southern Lebanon. A drone dropped two stun grenades on Nabatieh al-Fawqa five minutes apart. A drone struck a vehicle in the town of Siddiqine in the Tyre district, then carried out a second strike on the same location, injuring two people. Israeli reconnaissance drones flew over Beirut and its southern suburbs. Israeli forces also carried out a demolition operation in the town of Kounine in the Bint Jbeil district.

Bodies of Three Missing Persons Found in Wadi al-Salouqi After Ceasefire Announcement

The bodies of three missing persons were recovered, on Friday, July 3rd, in the Wadi al-Salouqi area immediately following the announcement of a ceasefire, along with one injured survivor. The injured man, Muhammad Ali Hussein from Aitaroun, was transferred to a hospital in Tyre, where his leg was amputated. The three deceased were identified as Hadi Kamal al-Raqqa from Shahabiyeh, Jawad Shadi Bazzi from Frun, and Ali Musa Qashmar from Houla.

Woman Killed by Husband in Bzebina, Akkar

A man identified as Kh.M. shot and killed his wife A.H. inside their home in the town of Bzebina in the Akkar district on Friday, July 3rd. The suspect turned himself in to security forces. Investigations were launched under judicial supervision. The Bzebina municipality condemned the killing, noting that the suspect is originally from Tripoli and is a resident rather than a native of the town.

Israeli Strikes and Military Activity Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Saturday, July 4th, missile strikes, sweeping operations, and artillery shelling across southern Lebanon. An Apache helicopter fired five missiles at the town of Majdal Zoun, while Israeli forces simultaneously conducted an extensive sweeping operation on the town's outskirts. Artillery targeted Mount Basil opposite the town of Ramia and Beit Lif in the Bint Jbeil district.

Israeli Strikes, Demolitions, and Military Activity Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Sunday, July 5th, airstrikes, artillery shelling, demolitions, and drone activity across southern Lebanon. An airstrike targeted the al-Hariq neighborhood between Kfar Tibnit and Nabatieh al-Fawqa. Artillery struck Deir Serian in the morning and the vicinity of Qantara in the Marjayoun district in the afternoon. A drone dropped a sound bomb on al-Mansouri in the Tyre district. Israeli drones flew over towns and villages surrounding Tyre and at low altitude over Baalbek and neighboring villages. Israeli forces carried out extensive demolition operations in the towns of Beit Yahoun and Kounine in the Bint Jbeil district.

WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. which prison)



WHAT:

Nature of the violation



HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
