War Remnant Explosion Injures Civilian in al-Mansouri; Israeli Forces Conduct Sweeping Operations

A war remnant exploded, on Monday, June 22nd, in the town of al-Mansouri, injuring a civilian who was transported to the hospital for treatment. Israeli forces stationed in al-Biyada simultaneously conducted sweeping operations toward the outskirts of the al-Mashaa neighborhood in al-Mansouri in the direction of Majdal Zoun.

UNDP Assessment Estimates \$1.38 Billion in Building Damage Across South Lebanon

The United Nations Development Programme, in coordination with Lebanon's National Council for Scientific Research, announced, on Monday, June 22nd, the results of a rapid building-level damage assessment across South Lebanon covering areas south of the Litani River. The assessment found that direct damage to buildings reached \$1.38 billion, with 11,095 buildings completely destroyed, affecting 17,891 housing units, 2,242 buildings partially damaged, and 9,311 sustaining minor damage. The most severely affected areas included Aytaroun and Bint Jbeil in the Bint Jbeil district, and Meiss Ej Jabal and Taybeh in the Marjayoun district. UNDP noted the assessment covers only direct damage to buildings as of April 29, 2026, and does not include damage to roads, bridges, electricity, water, or telecommunications infrastructure.

Israeli Strikes and Military Activity Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Tuesday, June 23rd, drone strikes and artillery shelling across southern Lebanon, targeting Braasheet, Kfar Tibnit, and Ayta al-Jabal, among others. A drone targeted a parked car on the outskirts of Braasheet toward Beit Yahoun with no injuries. Kfar Tibnit was hit by several artillery shells and three stun grenades. A drone flew at low altitude over Kfar Reman, the Tapline road, and al-Najda al-Shaabiyeh Hospital. Israeli forces also dropped a stun grenade on the outskirts of Ayta al-Jabal.

Israeli Forces Shoot Dead Two Rescue Workers Retrieving Bodies in Nabatieh al-Fawqa

Israeli forces opened fire, on Tuesday, June 23rd, on a group of young men near a bulldozer conducting road-clearing and body-retrieval operations in the al-Deir neighborhood of Nabatieh al-Fawqa, killing Mohammad Amhaz and Sajed Ibrahim al-Hajj Ali, and injuring a third person. The victims were working alongside an Islamic Health Authority team. Simultaneously, a drone dropped a stun grenade toward the bulldozer. The injured were transferred to al-Najda al-Shaabiyeh Hospital in Nabatieh, where the two victims later died of their wounds, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli Forces Fire on Civilians During Funeral Procession in Hadatha

Israeli forces opened fire, on Tuesday, June 23rd, toward a group of civilians attempting to conduct a burial at the Hadatha cemetery while accompanied by the Lebanese Army. Three Merkava tanks and a D9 bulldozer were also spotted near the cemetery at the time.

Wednesday

Israeli Strikes and Military Activity Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Wednesday, June 24th, drone strikes, artillery shelling, and sweeping operations across southern Lebanon, targeting the outskirts of Yater in the Bint Jbeil district with artillery, the al-Deir neighborhood of Nabatieh al-Fawqa with a guided missile, and Hadatha with artillery and combing operations. Israeli military vehicles were also reported moving overnight near Kounine, accompanied by gunfire.

Drone Strike on Car in Dohat Kfar Reman Kills Two

Israeli forces struck, on Wednesday, June 24th, a car in Dohat Kfar Reman with a drone, killing 2, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

OCHA Report Documents Over 300 Deaths and 900 Injuries from Ceasefire Violations in 2025

The United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs published, on Wednesday, June 24th, its Lebanon Humanitarian Fund Annual Report for 2025, documenting the humanitarian situation following the November 27, 2024, cessation of hostilities. The report recorded over 2,000 ceasefire violations throughout 2025, including artillery shelling, airstrikes, drone strikes, demolitions, and detonations, resulting in over 300 fatalities and nearly 900 injuries by December 31, 2025. The report also noted that Lebanon faced severe water scarcity with rainfall dropping by more than 50 percent in many areas, leaving approximately 900,000 people affected by water shortages, and that Lake Qaraoun recorded its lowest inflow in over 60 years. The report described Lebanon as facing a multi-layered crisis driven by the conflict, ongoing ceasefire violations, the influx of refugees following the collapse of the Syrian regime in December 2024, and prolonged socioeconomic and political instability.

Drone Strike on Car on Zawtar–Mayfadoun Road Kills Three

Israeli forces struck, on Thursday, June 25th, a car on the road between Zawtar and Mayfadoun in the Nabatieh district, killing 3 and injuring 1, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli Forces Burn Homes in Ain Arab After Ordering Residents to Evacuate

Israeli forces set fire, on Thursday, June 25th, to a number of homes in the town of Ain Arab in the Marjayoun district, following evacuation orders issued to residents the previous day requiring them to leave by 5:00 p.m. Residents had only returned to the town that morning after the Lebanese Army reopened the road linking Ain Arab to al-Mari.

Friday
June 26 2026

Israeli Forces Abduct Seven People from Ain Arab, Conduct Large-Scale Search Operation

Israeli forces abducted, on Friday, June 26th, seven people from the outskirts of the town of Ain Arab in the Marjayoun district and took them into occupied territory, before conducting a large-scale search operation inside the town's neighborhoods. The abducted included three residents of Ain Arab: Ali Moussa Ibrahim, Mohammad Ali Ibrahim, and Ali Nasser al-Rajab, and four others who were working in agricultural lands surrounding the town.

Israeli Ground Incursion from Haddatha Toward Haris; Homes Bulldozed and Burned in Markaba

Israeli forces carried out, on Friday, June 26th, a ground incursion using military vehicles and bulldozers from the town of Haddatha toward the outskirts of Haris in the Bint Jbeil district, positioning themselves inside a home and conducting sweeping operations in the surrounding area. Separately, Israeli forces carried out operations to bulldoze and burn homes in the town of Markaba.

Israeli Strikes and Military Activity Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Saturday, June 27th, drone strikes and military activity across southern Lebanon, targeting the area between Kounine and Braasheet in the Bint Jbeil district. Israeli forces also fired three stun grenades at the town of Bara'ashit and conducted search operations extending toward Byout al-Siyyad in the Tyre district. Israeli forces advanced toward the outskirts of Kfar Shouba in the Hasbaya district, accompanied by machine-gun fire.

Strike on Nabatieh al-Fawqa Kills One, Injures Two

Israeli forces struck, on Saturday, June 27th, the Farah Amusement Park junction in Nabatieh al-Fawqa with a drone, killing 1 and injuring 2, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli Strikes and Military Activity Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Sunday, June 28th, airstrikes, drone strikes, and artillery activity across southern Lebanon, targeting the outskirts of Mayfadoun in the Nabatieh district, Nabatieh al-Fawqa, the Deir Seryan-Taybeh area, and the Farran family home near the al-Maslaakh neighborhood junction in Nabatieh city. A stun grenade was dropped near the Teachers' House at the Nabatieh-Nabatieh al-Fawqa junction. Cluster munitions struck the outskirts of Shebaa and Chwaya in the Hasbaya district. A stun grenade dropped on the town of Burj Qalawiyeh in the Bint Jbeil district injured 2, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli Forces Continue Demolishing and Burning Homes in Kham

Israeli forces carried out, on Sunday, June 28th, demolitions and set homes on fire in the town of Kham, while military vehicles continued to move inside the town.

WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. which prison)



WHAT:

Nature of the violation



HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
