Monday
8 September 2025

Five killed and five injured in Israeli airstrike on Bekaa and Hermel

At least 7 raids targeted Hermel and Bekaa outskirts on Monday, September 8, killing 5 people and injuring five others according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Simultaneously, the Operations Center reported the injury of a shepherd after a soundbomb by an Israeli drone on the western outskirts of Mays al-Jabal.

Large fires in Dinniye and Halba extinguished

A fire broke out inside a house in Bakhoun, al-Dinniye, destroying one room on Monday, September 8. Civil defense personnel extinguished the fire, and the damage was only material with no human injuries.

In Halba, a large fire broke out in Wadi Halba, spreading to one of the houses and causing the blaze to spread to olive trees in the area.

Mina Municipality workers protest for their salaries

Accompanied by the Federation of Workers' and Employees' Unions in North Lebanon, municipality workers in Mina, Tripoli district, organized a sit-in in front of the union headquarters on Monday, September 8.

The workers protested the absence of their salaries for six months and the lack of medical and social benefits for more than two years, and threatened to close the municipal palace, according to the National News Agency.

Journalist Walid Abboud threatened with death and kidnapping

TV Presenter and Journalist Walid Abboud received a written threat in front of his home on Monday, September 8. The leaflets says Abboud's "time for reckoning has come", threatening with "punishments in the form of kidnapping, torture, and then physical liquidation".

Citizen killed by his worker in Baabda

Garage owner Hikmat al-Haddishti was killed by one of his workers, after the latter hit him on his head with a hammer following a dispute on Tuesday, September 9.

Israeli forces bomb house remains in Aitaroun and throw leaflets

Israeli forces blew up the remains of a house in the Khanouk area on the outskirts of Aitaroun at night on Tuesday, September 9, and left provocative leaflets in the area.

Simultaneously, an Israeli drone attacked a car between the towns of Zarut and Barja, Chouf district, causing a fire.

102 Cases of Violence Against Women in August

The National Commission for Lebanese Women and the General Directorate of Internal Security Forces highlighted violence incidents reported to the General Directorate's hotline during August on Tuesday, September 9.

The incidents were distributed as 90 physical violence cases, 10 emotional violence cases, 2 cases of sexual violence, and 0 cases of economic violence and other types.

Wednesday

Ministry of Economy issues 23 reports for consumer protection violation

Statement issued by the Ministry of Economy and Commerce on Wednesday, September 10:

During the period from September 1 to 5, 2025, the Consumer Protection Directorate received 54 complaints from citizens which were duly addressed. During this period, 569 inspection visits were conducted, including to commercial stores, gas stations, generators, gas filling centers, libraries, grocery stores, restaurants, butcher shops, and fishmongeries.

These inspections resulted in 23 citations being issued for various violations of the Consumer Protection Law and applicable laws [...]

The Ministry of Economy and Commerce affirms that it will continue its regulatory work without compromise [...]. To date, the Ministry has conducted 21,873 inspections since the beginning of the year.

Israeli drone falls into Adaisseh

According to the National News Agency, an Israeli drone crashed in the town of Adaisseh on Wednesday, September 10, and the Lebanese Army is inspecting it.

11 September 2025

Five injured and others killed in Israeli airstrike on Kfardonin and Ain Baal

An Israeli airstrike targeted a motorcycle in Kfardonin, Bint Jbeil district, injuring five people and injuring others on Thursday, September 11.

Another person was also killed in an Israeli airstrike that targeted Ain Baal, Al-Bazouriya road, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli forces bomb a school for the disabled in Aita al-Shaab

Israeli forces bombed a building belonging to a school for people with special needs in the Abu Tawil neighborhood on the outskirts of Aita al-Shaab at dawn on Thursday, September 11.

Series of Israeli airstrikes in different areas around Lebanon

A series of Israeli airstrikes targeted Ain Baal and Qalaat Mays between Zrarieh and Ansar, a bulldozer in Aitaroun, a motorcycle in Kfardonin in the South on Thursday, September 11.

In other locations, raids attacked the Shaara area - Baalbek and the eastern chain between the mountains of Janta and Qusaya.

Ministry of Agriculture detects major violation of cutting down forest trees in Zgharta

Statement issued by the Ministry of Agriculture on Thursday, September 11:

[...] A field investigation revealed that a violator had, without any legal license, cut down dozens of forest trees of the wild pine, oak, and holly species, amounting to tens of tons.

Subsequently, the Forestry Center team filed a report against the violator, and the case was referred to the relevant police station, which is taking the necessary measures in accordance with judicial instructions.

The Ministry of Agriculture affirms its commitment to continuing efforts, in coordination with the security forces and judicial authorities, to intensify field monitoring, protect forests and natural resources, and deter any violations that threaten their sustainability, in implementation of applicable laws and regulations and to preserve the environment.

One killed and two injured in Israeli airstrikes on Aita al-Jabal and Aitaroun

An Israeli airstrike on a car in Aita al-Jabal injured two citizens on Friday, September 12, and another person was killed in an Israeli strike on Aitaroun, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Simultaneously, an Israeli drone dropped a bomb on Dahira, while another bomb targeted a room in Naqoura with no injuries.

Israeli airstrikes and soundbombs in border areas

Israeli drones dropped soundbombs on Yarin and Wazzani, while a drone targeted Aitaroun on Friday, September 12.

Simultaneously, an unexploded missile left behind by the aggression was dismantled in Babliyeh, a house was blown up in Mays al-Jabal at dawn, and a search operation was conducted in Wazzani with machine guns.

ISF destroy seized narcotics from Regional Anti-Narcotics Bureaus in Zahle

Statement issued by The Public Relations Division of the Internal Security Forces General Directorate on Friday, September 12:

On September 11, 2025, upon the instructions of the competent judiciary, the Central Anti-Narcotics Bureau and the Regional Anti-Narcotics Bureau in Zahle, affiliated with the Judicial Police Unit, destroyed a quantity of seized narcotics at the newly constructed Dahr al-Baidar landfill.

[...] The destruction was supported by a force from the Special Group in the Judicial Police Unit and a force from the Information Branch.

The seized and destroyed materials are as follows:

- 2,257.5 kg of hashish
- 6.3 kg of marijuana
- 6,164,419 Captagon pills
- 26.15 kg of cocaine
- 1,112 liters of liquid raw materials
- 1,179 kg of solid raw materials

Israeli soundbombs and incursion in border villages

An Israeli drone threw a bomb and a soundbomb on [Aita al-Shaab](#) on Saturday, September 13, and another bomb was thrown in the vicinity of old [Kfarkila](#) square.

Army raid drug manufacturing lab in Yammouneh-Baalbek

Statement issued by The Army Command - Directorate of Orientation on Saturday, September 13:

As part of its efforts to combat drug manufacturing and trafficking, an Intelligence Directorate patrol, supported by an Army unit, raided a drug manufacturing lab in the Yammouneh-Baalbek area and seized a large quantity of drugs, along with raw materials used in drug manufacturing, weapons, and ammunition. The lab's equipment was also dismantled.

[...] The seized items were handed over, and investigations with the detainees were initiated under the supervision of the competent judiciary.

Israeli airstrike on Aita al-Shaab and bomb on Aitaroun

An Israeli raid targeted a house in Aita al-Shaab and another bomb attacked a bulldozer in Bir Nasser in [Aitaroun](#) with no injuries on Sunday, September 14.

Simultaneously, a sound bomb was thrown on Dahira, Tyre District, and an Israeli helicopter was found in [Houla](#) alongside Israeli helicopter nails in [Ramyeh](#).

REPORTING A VIOLATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS TO CLDH

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:

- **WHERE:** City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. what prison)
- **WHAT:** Nature of the violation
- **HOW:** A narrative description of what happened
- **WHEN:** Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)
- **TO WHOM:** Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.
- **WHO** is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
