31 August - 6 September 2026

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Monday 31
September 2026

Israeli Artillery Shelling and Explosion Affect Southern Towns

Israeli forces carried out, on Monday, August 31st, artillery shelling and an explosion across southern Lebanon. Artillery struck Houla, Mansouri, and Byout al-Siyyad overnight and into the early morning. A large explosion was later carried out in Arnoun, in a neighborhood adjacent to the northern side of Beaufort Castle.

Tuesday 1
September 2026

Israeli Forces Demolish Homes and Shell Southern Towns

Israeli forces carried out, on Tuesday, September 1st, explosions, artillery shelling, and demolitions across southern Lebanon. A violent explosion was carried out in Rashaf in the Bint Jbeil district. In the Tyre district, heavy military vehicles advanced toward the Fourth Neighborhood of Mansouri, where Israeli forces demolished several homes. Israeli artillery also shelled the vicinity of Houla in the Marjayoun district. The destruction of residential property further affected the ability of residents to return safely to their towns.

Wednesday 2
September 2026

Israeli Attacks Destroy Civilian Homes and Damage Cemetery in Nabatieh Area

Israeli forces carried out, on Wednesday, September 2nd, airstrikes, drone strikes, artillery shelling, explosions, and sweeping operations across southern Lebanon. Overnight airstrikes destroyed additional civilian homes in the Roueiss neighborhood of Nabatieh al-Fawqa. An airstrike on Arabsalim destroyed a cemetery room containing burial equipment, extensively damaged graves and headstones, and shattered windows in dozens of nearby homes. A drone later struck a home in Nabatieh al-Fawqa, with no injuries reported.

Artillery heavily shelled the Ali al-Taher heights, al-Dabsha hill, Doha Kfar Roummame, and the outskirts of Maifadoun and Zawtar al-Sharqiyyeh, with NNA reporting the use of phosphorus shells. Machine-gun fire was also directed toward the outskirts of Zawtar al-Sharqiyyeh. Separate drone strikes targeted Yater and the Deir neighborhood of Nabatieh al-Fawqa, while large explosions were carried out in Kfar Tibnit, Beit Leef, Mansouri, and Hadatha. Artillery also struck Mansouri.

Drone Strike on Residential Neighborhood in Nabatieh Kills One and Injures Another

Israeli forces struck, on Wednesday, September 2nd, the Roueiss neighborhood near al-Hadiqa al-Maasouma in Nabatieh with a drone, killing one person and injuring another. A second drone later fired a guided missile at an apartment in the al-Masleh neighborhood of Nabatieh.

Thursday
3 September 2026

Israeli Force Enters Halta, and Confines Residents as Attacks Continue Across Southern Lebanon

An Israeli force entered, on Thursday, September 3rd, Halta Farm in the Hasbaya district, surrounded several homes, and prevented residents from leaving. The entry reportedly followed telephone calls to a municipal council member and the town's mukhtar. The operation restricted residents' freedom of movement and access outside their homes.

Elsewhere in southern Lebanon, Israeli forces carried out explosions in Hadatha, Wadi Braasheet, Bani Hayyan, and Kfar Tibnit. An Israeli drone dropped two sound bombs on the Eziya–Mansouri road, while artillery struck Mansouri. A Merkava tank and a D9 bulldozer also advanced toward the town. The explosion in Kfar Tibnit was reported to be the largest carried out in the town, generating thick smoke and causing fear among residents.

Friday 4
September 2026

Israeli Attacks Kill Four and Injure Thirty-Two Across Lebanon

Israeli attacks carried out on Friday, September 4th, killed four people and injured 32 across several areas, according to the final toll issued by the Ministry of Public Health's Emergency Operations Center. One person was killed, and three were injured in Nabatieh, while two people were killed in a strike on a motorcycle in Kfar Roummane. In Maifadoun, an 18-year-old woman was killed, and nine people were injured, including three women and two children. Two people were injured in Nabatieh al-Fawqa, one in al-Kfour, 16 in al-Ramadiyeh, including four women and three children, and one in Ain al-Tineh in the West Bekaa.

Israeli Artillery Shelling and Explosions Affect Southern Towns

Israeli forces carried out, on Friday, September 4th, artillery shelling and explosions across southern Lebanon. Artillery struck the vicinity of Beit Leef and Sarbin, as well as Mansouri, Majdal Zoun, Byout al-Siyyad, Zawtar al-Sharqiyyeh, and the outskirts of Maifadoun. A Merkava tank also fired toward residential neighborhoods in Zawtar al-Sharqiyyeh. Israeli forces later carried out explosions in Mansouri and shelled Bani Hayyan.

Five People Released from Israeli Detention and Transferred to Lebanon

The International Committee of the Red Cross facilitated, on Thursday and Friday, September 3rd and 4th, the transfer to Lebanon of five people released from Israeli detention. One person was transferred on Thursday and four on Friday. The four people released on Friday were received at Ras Naqoura and transported through Mansouri before being handed over to the Lebanese Army in Tyre. The available reports did not state the legal basis or duration of their detention, or provide information regarding the conditions in which they had been held.

Saturday & Sunday
5 and 6 September
2026

Israeli Forces Target Homes and Infrastructure in Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Saturday, September 5th, artillery shelling, explosions, and operations targeting homes and infrastructure across southern Lebanon. Artillery struck Wadi al-Slouqi and Wadi al-Houjair. In Mansouri, drones dropped explosive material over homes after a series of explosions in the town. More than 14 explosive operations were reported on the outskirts of Mansouri toward Majdal Zoun, affecting homes and infrastructure. Israeli forces also carried out large explosions in Bani Hayyan in the Marjayoun district.

Israeli Strikes Kill Seven and Injure Twenty in Nabatieh Area

Israeli forces carried out, on Sunday, September 6th, a series of airstrikes and drone strikes across the Nabatieh area, killing seven people and injuring 20. Morning airstrikes killed two people and injured two in Nabatieh al-Fawqa, injured eight people in the Hay al-Rahbat neighborhood of Nabatieh, including a woman and a girl, killed two women and injured six people in Arabsalim, including two girls, and injured four women in Kfar Roummane. A subsequent drone strike on a parking lot in Nabatieh al-Tahta killed three additional people.

The attacks also destroyed homes and other buildings in Nabatieh, Nabatieh al-Fawqa, Arabsalim, and Kfar Roummane and damaged dozens of nearby shops and cafés. An evacuation warning was issued for a building in Arabsalim before it was struck and destroyed. Sayyida al-Maasouma Garden was also struck, while additional drone strikes targeted a motorcycle near the Teachers' House and the al-Deir neighborhood of Nabatieh al-Fawqa.

Drone Strike on Parking Lot in Nabatieh al-Tahta Kills Three

An Israeli drone struck, on Sunday, September 6th, a parking lot in Nabatieh al-Tahta, killing three people, according to the Ministry of Public Health's Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli Strike Damages Ministry of Finance Offices and Disrupts Public Services

An Israeli strike on Nabatieh damaged, on Sunday, September 6th, the Ministry of Finance building in the city. The ministry instructed the General Directorate of Finance to safeguard official files and documents and take measures to maintain services. The damage placed public records at risk and threatened the continuity of services provided to residents.

Israeli Strikes and Artillery Shelling Continue Across Southern Lebanon

Israeli forces carried out, on Sunday, September 6th, airstrikes, artillery shelling, and explosions across southern Lebanon. Artillery struck Kounine in the Bint Jbeil district. Multiple airstrikes targeted Mansouri, where Israeli forces later carried out a large explosion. Heavy artillery also struck al-Marj between Haniyeh and Mansouri.

Israeli Airstrikes Completely Destroy Ghandour Hospital in Nabatieh al-Fawqa

Israeli airstrikes completely destroyed, on Sunday, September 6th, Ghandour Hospital in Nabatieh al-Fawqa. According to the Ministry of Public Health, the hospital had stopped operating approximately two months earlier because of repeated attacks in Nabatieh and its surroundings. Before its closure, it had provided essential health services to residents and had served for an extended period as a displacement shelter. The destruction further damaged health infrastructure already affected by the hostilities and eliminated a facility that had played a central role in providing medical and humanitarian services to the surrounding population.

WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details
(e.g. which prison)



HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



WHAT:

Nature of the violation



WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
