### **Airstrikes and shelling intensify across Shaqra, Tyre, and al-Mansouri**

Israeli airstrikes struck Safad al-Battikh, Beit Yahoun, Aita al-Jabal, Braachit, Burj Rahhal, Deir Antar, Adchit, Qaaqaiyat al-Jisr, Deir Qanoun Ras al-Ain, Yater, Kafra, Kfarreman, al-Sireh al-Gharbiyeh, Zbdine, Mazraat Mushrif, al-Qantara, the outskirts of Tebnine, areas between al-Shaaitiyeh and al-Ramadiyeh, al-Mansouri plain, al-Qleileh, Shaqra, Bayout al-Siyad, and Majdal Zoun on Monday, April 13.

Clashes were also reported near Naqoura and al-Bayyada, and an enemy drone was shot down over Jabal Saghbine.

Artillery shelling targeted Bayout al-Siyad, villages in the western sector of Tyre, Kafra, Yater, the outskirts of Yanooh, Ras al-Ain, the entrance of Bint Jbeil, Shamaa castle, and the hills of Shamaa, alongside intermittent shelling across multiple areas.

### **Widespread airstrikes and artillery fire reported across southern Lebanon**

Airstrikes targeted multiple areas, including the Abbasiyeh junction in Tyre, Khiyam, Aita al-Jabal, Adloun, Qana, Sair al-Gharbiyeh, Burj Rahhal, areas near the destroyed Qasmiyeh bridge, and the Mashghara plain on Tuesday, April 14.

Drone strikes hit Aitit, al-Shahabiyeh, Siddiqine, and a motorcycle in Aabba, while additional strikes were reported on Srifa, al-Shahabiyeh, Zawtar al-Sharqiyyeh, Kafardounine, areas between Ain Baal and Aitit, and overnight on Tebnine, al-Shabriha, and al-Shahabiyeh. Further strikes also hit Braachit and Siddiqine.

Artillery shelling and military activity intensified, with heavy shelling targeting Bint Jbeil and its surroundings. Shelling also hit al-Mansouri and al-Qleileh, and helicopters opened heavy machine-gun fire toward Khiyam, while Israeli forces demolished remaining homes in Mays al-Jabal using bulldozers.

### **Airstrikes in Ansariyeh, Abbassieh and Saida leave multiple casualties**

In al-Abbasiyeh, Tyre district, airstrikes resulted in 7 deaths, including a child, and 3 injured, all of them children on Wednesday, April 15. A separate strike at the Abbasiyeh junction killed one person and wounded 8 others, including 2 females.

In Nabatieh district, a strike on Jbaa killed 4 people, including 2 females. In Ansariyeh, Saida district, 5 people were killed, including 2 children, and 5 others were injured. In the city of Tyre, an additional strike resulted in the death of a young man, all according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

### **Heavy Israeli airstrikes and shelling reported across southern Lebanon**

Israeli airstrikes targeted the outskirts of Zrariyeh and Qasmiyeh, Haris, Beit Yahoun, Kfar Sir, Mifdoun, Zbeddine, al-Shahabiyeh, al-Qatrani, Debbine, Blat, al-Ahmadiyeh, al-Qantara, Burj Qalawiyeh, Nabatieh, Deir al-Zahrani, al-Hanniyeh, Breqaa, Sair al-Gharbiyeh, the outskirts of al-Halousiyeh, as well as al-Majadel, Jbaa, and villages in the Zahrani area on Wednesday, April 15.

Artillery shelling and military activity intensified the same day, with heavy shelling targeting Khiyam, Aita al-Jabal, Haris, al-Mansouri, and the surroundings of Bint Jbeil and Yaroun amid ongoing clashes. An Apache helicopter opened fire over the coastal plain between al-Mansouri and al-Qleileh and launched rockets. Israeli forces also carried out a large explosion in al-Taybeh, alongside continued shelling across multiple areas.

### **Strikes across Adloun, Tyre and Chouf leave multiple casualties**

In Adloun, Saida district, an airstrike caused 3 deaths, including 2 females, and 21 injuries on Thursday, April 16. In the nearby towns of Saksakiyeh and Zrariyeh, strikes resulted in 7 deaths and 27 injuries. In al-Ghaziyyeh, another strike killed 7 people and injured 33.

In Saadiyat, Chouf district, one woman was killed and two children were injured. In al-Shahabiyeh, Tyre district, the combined toll of strikes over April 15 and 16 reached 9 dead and 6 injured, including 5 killed in the April 15 strike and 4 more killed on April 16, according to the reported breakdown by the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

### **Strikes hit Nabatieh, Tyre, and Jezzine areas as attacks widen**

Israeli airstrikes targeted Aitit, Debbine, Deir Qanoun Ras al-Ain, Khirbet al-Duweir, Adloun, Ansariyeh, Jouaya, Bafliyeh, Qana, Bint Jbeil and surrounding towns, Kfarhata, al-Rihan, al-Wardiyeh, Sejoud in Jezzine, Dbaal, Ghaziyeh, Zrariyeh, Bnaafoul, al-Qleileh, Nabatieh, Toul, Ain Baal, Hanaweyh, Siddiqine, areas around Kfarhata, Zawtar al-Sharqiyyeh, the outskirts of Arab Salim, Ain Bousouar, Kfarhouneh, Kafra, Haris, Touline, and Wadi Shbeil in al-Qatrani on Thursday, April 16.

Artillery shelling and military activity escalated the same day, with shelling reported on the outskirts of Nabatieh al-Fawqa, Beit Yahoun, the orchards of Tayr Debba, and along the Tyre coastline, while a fire belt encircled the town of al-Qsair.

### One killed and two injured in Israeli airstrike on Kounin

An Israeli airstrike attacked a car and a motorcycle in Kounin, Bint Jbeil district, killing one person and injuring two others, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

### **Shelling hits Qantara, Khiyam, Deir Mimas and Kounine as Israeli attacks continue**

Artillery shelling targeted the outskirts of al-Qantara in Marjeyoun, Byout al-Siyad, and Deir Mimas, where a house caught fire following overnight strikes. Israeli forces also fired two shells toward Bayout al-Siyad and carried out a booby-trapping operation in Khiyam on Friday, April 17, coinciding with the start of the ceasefire.

Further fire targeted an ambulance team from the Islamic Health Committee in Kounine, where artillery shells and heavy machine-gun fire caused injuries among responders.

### **Explosions and artillery fire reported across Marjeyoun and eastern sector**

Israeli artillery shelling targeted Tall Nahas, the outskirts of Deir Mimas, and the surroundings of Deir Sirian, where strikes also reached the riverbed opposite Zawtar al-Sharqiyeh on Saturday, April 18.

In parallel, Israeli forces carried out a large-scale demolition operation of houses in the towns of Markaba and al-Taybeh, while another explosion was reported in Khiyam as part of ongoing field activity in the area.

### Burned houses in Qantara and bombings in Bayada by Israel

Israeli forces burned houses in Qantara, Marjeyoun district, while simultaneously bombing other houses in Bayada and Naqoura on Sunday, April 19.

### Lebanese Army removes an Israeli earthen barrier in Mari-Ain Arab road

The Lebanese Army mentioned in a statement on Sunday, April 19, that a specialized army unit has removed an earthen barrier put by Israel in the Mari-Ain Arab road and has established an observation post in the area.

## WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details  
(e.g. which prison)



## HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



## TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



## WHAT:

Nature of the violation



## WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



## WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
