### **Israeli Strikes Across Southern Lebanon, Displacement Orders Issued for Seven Villages**

Israeli forces carried out, on Monday, June 1st, extensive airstrikes, drone strikes, and artillery shelling across southern Lebanon, killing at least 9 people. A drone strike in Aba killed Ali Wahbi from Harouf and injured two others. A drone strike in the Maqasid neighborhood of Nabatieh killed Ali Habib Jaber, 75. Overnight strikes on Kfar Sir killed Ali Rizk, Mahdi Ibrahim Skafi, Moaan Mahmoud Sbiti, Hassan Sbiti, and Mohammad Ahmad Rida. Targeted towns included Marwanieh, Bazouriyeh, Siddiqin, Yater, Mansouri, Byout al-Siyyed, Hanawiyeh, al-Majadel, Sajd, Rashkananieh, Shahbiyeh, Kfar Tibnit, Nabatieh al-Fawqa, Nabatieh city, Kfar Sir, Harouf, Shahour, Toul, Shoukin, Aba, Salaa, Mleikh, Houmin al-Fawqa, Kfarhouneh, Haouche Tyre, Maaroub, Zrariyeh, Blat, and Debbin.

### **Strikes Near Jabal Amel Hospital Kill Four, Injure 127 Including 39 Medical Staff**

Israeli forces struck, on Monday, June 1st, buildings adjacent to Jabal Amel Hospital in Tyre on multiple occasions, killing 4 and injuring 127, including 39 members of the medical, nursing, and administrative staff – among them 4 doctors, 27 nurses, and 8 administrative employees, four of whom were in critical condition in intensive care. The strikes caused extensive damage to multiple hospital departments, the ICU, the dialysis center, and the parking area, and cut electricity to intensive care units, interrupting oxygen supply to patients, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

### **Massacre in Marwanieh Kills Six Including Two Children**

Israeli forces struck, on Monday, June 1st, a residential building in Marwanieh in the Sidon district. According to a statement issued by the Public Health Emergency Operations Center on June 2nd, the strike killed 6, including a woman and 2 children, and injured 4, including a child and a woman.

### **Drone Strike on Car Kills Dentist and Two Children on Khardali Road**

Israeli forces struck, on Monday, June 1st, a car on the Khardali road, killing Dr. James Karam, a dentist from Qlayaa, along with his two children, Theodosia and Tony, as the family was returning home after traveling to the Lebanese University in Hadath where the children had been scheduled to sit exams before they were postponed.

### **Israeli Strikes Across Southern Lebanon**

Israeli forces carried out, on Tuesday, June 2nd, multiple airstrikes, drone strikes, and artillery shelling across southern Lebanon, targeting Deir Qanoun, Ras al-Ain, Srifa, Siddiqin, Ramadiyeh, Tibnin, Mashouq, Nabatieh, Mifdoun, Shoukin, Jebchit, Aba, Kfar Tibnit, Nabatieh al-Fawqa, and Qalawiyeh. Israeli forces carried out demolition and sweep operations in Debbin with heavy machine-gun fire and artillery, and advanced toward Blat. An Israeli tank shelled Byout al-Siyyed from positions in Bayada, and Israeli helicopters dropped munitions over Ras al-Naqoura sea area.

### **Drone Strike Injures Lebanese Army Officer and Soldier on Deir al-Zahrani–Nabatieh Road**

The Lebanese Army announced, on Tuesday June 2nd, that an Israeli drone targeted a Lebanese Army vehicle on the Deir al-Zahrani–Nabatieh road, injuring an officer and a soldier, describing the attack as part of a pattern of deliberate targeting of army personnel, vehicles, and positions.

## **Strike Near Tibnin Hospital Injures Doctor and Five Staff; Israeli Threats Against Hospital**

Israeli forces struck, on Tuesday, June 2nd, the vicinity of Tibnin Governmental Hospital in the Bint Jbeil district, injuring 11, including a doctor and 5 hospital staff, and causing damage to the facility, according to the [Public Health Emergency Operations Center](#). The Ministry of Public Health rejected Israeli allegations against the hospital, which is the only operational health facility in the Bint Jbeil district, [warning](#) that such claims constituted a direct threat to a civilian government institution.

## **Israeli Strikes Across Southern Lebanon**

Israeli forces carried out, on Wednesday, June 3rd, multiple airstrikes and drone strikes across southern Lebanon, [killing 6](#) in Housh and a [Lebanese Army](#) soldier on the Nabatieh–Kfar Tibnit road. Additional strikes targeted Nabatieh al-Fawqa, Nabatieh city, Siddiqin, Adshit, Marj Harouf, Shahour, Kawthariyat al-Ruz, Mifdoun, Hawsh Tyre, Wadi Hassan in Tayr Harfa, Majdal Zoun, Zibqin, Sahel al-Qlayleh, and Srifa.

## **Israeli Forces Directly Target Risala Ambulance in Shahour, Killing Two Paramedics**

Israeli forces struck, on Wednesday, June 3rd, an ambulance belonging to the Risala Association directly on the Shahour–Maaroub road, killing 2 paramedics and critically injuring a third, according to the [Public Health Emergency Operations Center](#).

## **Four Attacks on Healthcare Workers in Under 24 Hours; Zibdin Paramedic Killed**

Israeli forces carried out, on [Wednesday, June 3rd](#), what the Public Health Emergency Operations Center described as four attacks on healthcare personnel and facilities in under 24 hours: a paramedic was targeted in Arab Salim. Tibnin Hospital was threatened, and an Islamic Health Authority rescue team in [Zibdin](#) was directly targeted, killing a paramedic and injuring another.

## **Lebanese Parliament Justice Committee Approves Bill Abolishing Death Penalty**

Lebanon's parliamentary justice committee approved, on [Wednesday, June 3rd](#), a bill abolishing the death penalty from Lebanese law, replacing it with life imprisonment under strict conditions. A moratorium on executions has been in effect since 2004. Justice Minister Adel Nassar endorsed the bill, which now requires a full parliamentary vote. Committee chairman Georges Atallah stated the approval brought Lebanon in line with international human rights conventions.

## **UNIFIL Peacekeeper Killed Near Marjayoun**

A [UNIFIL](#) peacekeeper, Serbian Staff Sergeant Milovan Jovanovic, died on Thursday, June 4th, of wounds sustained when mortar fire struck his position near Marjayoun, becoming the seventh UN peacekeeper killed in Lebanon since March 2nd. A second Israeli strike near Tibnin Governmental Hospital destroyed 16 houses in the town.

## **Israeli Strikes Across Southern Lebanon and Western Bekaa**

Israeli forces carried out, on Thursday, June 4th, multiple airstrikes and drone strikes across southern Lebanon and the Western Bekaa, killing at least 11 people. A drone strike killed a man at the Bfaroue junction on the Deir Zahrani road. A drone strike on a family car near the Nmeirieh junction injured three. A drone strike on a scooter in Shahour killed its driver. A strike on a residential neighborhood in Tyre killed 3 and injured 7, including 3 children. A strike on the Abbasiyeh cemetery killed 3. Additional strikes targeted the Bint Jbeil district, attacking the villages of Hadatha, Tibnin, Haris, Kafra, and Harin.

## **Israeli Strikes Across Southern Lebanon**

Israeli forces carried out, on Friday, June 5th, multiple airstrikes and drone strikes across southern Lebanon. A drone struck a motorcycle on the Bir al-Salasil–Kfardounin road, killing the driver. A drone struck a motorcycle on the Deir Zahrani highway, killing one person, and another drone targeted a Rapid car in the same area. A drone struck a car on the Hawsh Tyre road, causing injuries. Additional strikes targeted Aramta, Jabal Safi, Jabal al-Rayhan, Kawthariyat al-Sayyad, Froun, Ghandouriyeh, Anqoun, Kfara, Sahel al-Qlayleh, al-Majadel, Sarafand, Babliyah, Marwaniyah, Qaqaiyet al-Sanawbar, Deir Qanoun al-Nahr, and Mleikh.

## **UN and Lebanese Government Launch Revised Flash Appeal for \$639.9 Million**

The United Nations and the Lebanese Government jointly launched, on Friday, June 5th, a revised humanitarian Flash Appeal seeking \$639.9 million to assist 1.4 million people through August 2026. UN Humanitarian Coordinator Imran Riza stated that more than 3,500 people had been killed and over 10,000 injured since March 2nd, with nearly one million people displaced. The appeal called for de-escalation, respect for international humanitarian law, unhindered humanitarian access, and scaled-up funding.

### **Israeli Strikes Across Southern Lebanon**

Israeli forces carried out, on Saturday, June 6th, multiple airstrikes and drone strikes across southern Lebanon, killing at least 5 people. An Israeli airstrike on the Khardali–Kfar Tibnit road killed three Lebanese Army personnel: Brigadier General Wissam Sabra, Captain Elie Khoury, and Soldier Hussein Ghazal. A drone struck a motorcycle on the Zefta road, killing one civilian. A drone struck two people on a motorcycle on the Wata Aaba road between Aba and Doueir, killing one. Additional strikes targeted Shehabiyeh, Jouaya, Zrariyeh, Sarafand, Ansariyeh, Aramta, Sajad, Mashghara, Wadi Zifin, Yater, Ain Baal, Deir Qanoun al-Nahr, Qlaileh, Deir Kifa, Rihan, and the Qatrani-Tajammouh Shbeil area.

### **Airstrike on Saksakiyeh Kills Two Women, Injures 22**

Israeli forces struck, on Saturday, June 6th, the town of Saksakiyeh in the Sidon district, killing 2 women and injuring 22, including 3 children and a woman, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

### **Strike on Mreijeh in Southern Suburbs of Beirut Kills Two, Injures 20**

Israeli forces struck, on Sunday, June 7th, the Mreijeh area in the southern suburbs of Beirut, killing 2 and injuring 20, including 4 children and 4 women, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:



## WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. which prison)



## WHAT:

Nature of the violation



## HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



## WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



## TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



## WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
