Three people killed in Anfeh fire

The National News Agency reported that three bodies were recovered from a fire that broke out in the afternoon inside a factory in Anfeh on Monday, November 24.

Israeli bombs and airstrikes over Blida, Nabatieh

Israeli artillery shells targeted the area between Aitaroun and Blida, and mock raids were conducted on Nabatieh and Iqlim al-Tuffah on Monday, November 24.

Simultaneously, Civil defense personnel extinguished a fire between Yaroun and Zalloutieh in the midst of Israeli shelling.

Baabda court grants citizenship for the wife of a Lebanese man

The Mount Lebanon Court of First Instance in Baabda has issued a ruling granting Lebanese citizenship to a woman who had been unregistered and spent nearly twenty-five years without legal status despite being married to a Lebanese man and having children with him on Monday, November 24.

Israeli phosphorus shells fired in Bint Jbeil

Israeli forces fired phosphorus artillery shells at the outskirts of Rmeish and Yaroun in Bint Jbeil on Tuesday, November 25, without any injuries or casualties recorded.

Israeli forces drop soundbombs on southern villages and enter Lebanese area

Israeli soundbombs were thrown in Mays al-Jabal and Maroun al-Ras while a drone crashed in Karkila on Wednesday, November 26, and two shells fired toward al-Hawana area near Ramya.

Simultaneously, Israeli forces crossed the Blue Line and entered Lebanese territory, and invaded a house in Mays al-Jabal, while other forces carried out bulldozing operations in al-Dawawir site.

Doctor involved in trafficking new born babies arrested

**Statement issued by the General Directorate of the State Security – Media, Guidance, and Public Relations
Department on Wednesday, November 27:**

As part of the ongoing efforts to pursue human trafficking networks, and following information regarding a doctor's involvement with an organized gang that illegally sells and transports newborn babies,

a patrol from the South Regional Directorate arrested the doctor (J.F.). The investigation revealed that the doctor facilitated the gang's activities by falsifying birth certificates and registration documents to conceal the identities of the newborns and register them illegally.

It was also discovered that the doctor was wanted on an outstanding arrest warrant issued by the investigating judge in Mount Lebanon.

Israeli bombs and airstrikes on Houla, Adaisseh, and Wazzani

An Israeli artillery shell was thrown on the outskirts of Houla and another grenade on Adaisseh, while airstrikes were conducted on Jarmaq and Mahmoudiya areas on Thursday, November 27.

Simultaneously, Israeli forces opened gunfire on farmers in Wazzani with no injuries reported, according to the National News Agency.

Dead body found in Saida

Local rescue teams in Saida found the dead body of a man, identified later as Syrian, near the coastal road in the city on Friday, November 28.

Israeli bombs target Qantara, Blida, and Houla

An Israeli drone targeted a Rapid car Qantara with no injuries reported on Friday, November 28, while explosive bombs hit a house in Houla and three more shells targeted the Kilometer 9 area between the towns of Blida and Aitaroun.

Bekaa Investigation Unit arrests two individuals using sewage water to irrigate crops

According to the ISF, two landowners in Bekaa, near the Litani River, were arrested for irrigating their crops with sewage water on Friday, November 27.

The land was a 30,000 square meter plot of land planted with corn belonging to two brothers, and laboratory analysis of the water revealed that it was unsuitable for irrigating crops.

Israeli soundbombs on Mays al-Jabal and Rmeish; raid on Alma al-Shaab

Two Israeli soundbombs were dropped on Mays al-Jabal and on a shepherd in Rmeish respectively on Saturday, November 30, while an Israeli airstrike targeted Alma al-Shaab.

Israeli soundbomb and artillery shells in the South: combing in Aitaroun

An Israeli airstrike attacked an excavator in Shebaa with no injuries on Sunday, November 30, while a soundbomb was fired towards Maroun al-Ras.

Simultaneously, a combing operation with machine guns attacked Aitaroun, while incendiary shells were fired at Jabal Blat between Beit Leef and Ramiya.

ISF arrests a man that killed his wife and dumped her body

Statement issued by the General Directorate of the Internal Security Forces – Public Relations Division on Sunday, November 30:

On November 15, 2025, a decomposed body was found lying by the roadside in the Ramhala area on the Qadi Bridge road. The forensic doctor's examination determined the body to be that of a woman.

During the investigation, the Information Branch discovered a previous missing person report filed at the regional station concerning N.H. (born in 1999, Syrian national). Her mother had filed the missing person report. Her husband, S.Z., was also questioned at the time. (Born in 1994, Syrian)

He claimed that on November 11, 2025, he received a WhatsApp message from her informing him of her desire to go to her family's home in Aramoun, and that he granted her permission. However, he later lost contact with her, and when he inquired with her family, they informed him that she had not arrived. He then claimed she was missing, asserting that there were no disputes between them.

On November 21, 2025, after careful surveillance, the Branch's patrols were able to arrest him in the town of Aramoun.

WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details
(e.g. which prison)



HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



WHAT:

Nature of the violation



WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
