Monday
6 October 2025

Two killed and four injured in an Israeli airstrike on Zebdin

An Israeli airstrike targeted a car in Zebdin, causing a fire and killing two people and wounding 4 others on Monday, October 6, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

The raid resulted in the death of a couple injured from the [Pagers](#) attack last year, who also lost their two sons late 2023 by Israeli strikes.

Israeli airstrikes on Kfarkila and Hermel

According to the National News Agency, a fire broke out between Deir Mimas and Kfarkila after Israeli drones fired a firebomb on Monday, October 6.

Two more airstrikes targeted [Hermel](#) outskirts and two others on the [Harbata](#) outskirts.

Stall owners in Saida protest in front of municipality

Vegetable stall owners staged a sit-in in front of the municipality before proceeding to the building's courtyard on Monday, October 6.

According to the National News Agency, the protest was caused by the removal of the stalls under the municipality's plan to organize the stalls.

Tuesday
7 October 2025

Two killed and one injured in Israeli airstrikes on Yater and Deir Amas

One person was killed and another person was injured in an Israeli airstrike on a car in [Deir Amas](#) on Tuesday, October 7, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Another airstrike attacked a bulldozer in Wadi Maryamin, Yater, killing its driver.

Israeli bombs dropped on Sultaniyeh, Adaisseh, and Ras al-Naqoura

Israeli raids threw two soundbombs at [Adaisseh](#) and another soundbomb on Ras al-Naqoura on Tuesday, October 7. Another raid threw a firebomb at a house in [Sultaniyeh](#).

Wednesday
8 October 2025

Cafe in Houla bombed and destroyed by Israel

Israeli forces bombed a cafe in [Houla](#) and destroyed it completely at dawn on Wednesday, October 8, with a series of repeated attacks at night.

ISF arrests a citizen blackmailing girls on Tiktok

Statement issued by The General Directorate of State Security – Media, Guidance, and Public Relations Department on Wednesday, October 8:

As part of the fight against cybercrimes that undermine moral and social values, the Southern Regional Directorate of the Syrian State Security arrested (M.A.) after receiving accurate information that he was blackmailing girls via the TikTok app, exploiting his account's popularity to obtain money or push them into inappropriate behavior.

During the investigation, it was revealed that his phone contained indecent videos that he was sharing with a number of his friends.

Legal measures were taken against him based on the instructions of the competent judiciary.

Lebanese Army arrested a citizen for killing a soldier after stabbing him

Statement issued by The Army Command - Directorate of Orientation on Wednesday, October 8:

Following a series of raids carried out by an army unit and security follow-up by the Intelligence Directorate, a citizen was arrested on October 8, 2025, in Tripoli for stabbing a soldier, killing him, during a dispute that erupted between them in the Mankoubin area of Tripoli on October 7, 2025, due to personal disputes.

An investigation has been initiated with the detainee under the supervision of the competent judiciary.

Thursday
9 October 2025

Two injured in Blida and Kfarshouba by Israeli bombs and war remenants

One person was injured in Blida after a war remnant exploded on Thursday, October 9, and another was injured in [Kfarshouba](#) by an Israeli soundbomb, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Simultaneously, Israeli forces blew up a house in [Mays al-Jabal](#) at dawn and dropped a soundbomb on [Wazzani](#).

Friday
10 October 2025

105 Cases of Violence Against Women in September

The National Commission for Lebanese Women and the General Directorate of Internal Security Forces highlighted violence incidents reported to the General Directorate's hotline during August on Friday, October 10.

The incidents were distributed as 97 physical violence cases, 8 emotional violence cases, and 0 cases of economic violence, sexual violence, and other types.

General Security dismantles a network cooperating with Israel

Statement issued by the General Directorate of General Security, Media Affairs Office on Friday, October 10:

As part of its fight against espionage networks, the General Directorate of General Security dismantled a network operating on behalf of the Israeli enemy.

The network was planning terrorist attacks, including bombings and assassinations inside Lebanon, and arrested some of its members. As a result of the investigation, one of the detainees admitted responsibility for the network's previous assassinations of party officials in the Islamic Group [...]

The details and circumstances of the case will be announced after the completion of the ongoing investigations under the supervision of the relevant authorities.

Lina Tabbal arrived in Tripoli after participating in Global Sumood Flotilla

Activist Dr. Lina Tabbal arrived in her hometown Tripoli after returning to Lebanon on Friday, October 10, and was greeted in Nour Square by dozens of citizens.

Tabbal was detained by Israeli forces with her colleagues on the Global Sumood Flotilla aiming to break the siege on Gaza.

Saturday and Sunday
11 and 12 October
2025

One killed and another injured in 10 Israeli airstrikes on al-Msayleh

At least 10 Israeli airstrikes targeted [al-Msalyeh](#) area in Saida district during night, killing one person and injuring another on Saturday, October 11.

Another person was also killed in an Israeli airstrike on a car in [Burj Qalawiyah](#).

Israeli soundbombs on Aita al-Shaab, Kfarkila, and Blida

An Israeli march threw two bombs at a bulldozer in Blida on Saturday, October 11. Additionally, Israeli forces threw explosive devices at an uninhabited house in [Aita al-Shaab](#), and one soundbomb hit [Kfarkila](#).

Simultaneously, several civil defense personnel were forced out of Tallet al-Hamames in Kfarkila while trying to extinguish a [fire](#), caused by Israeli drones flying at very low altitude.

Israeli attacks cause damage to transmission networks of Electricite du Liban

Israeli attacks on al-Msayleh caused significant damage to the transmission network in the area on Saturday, October 11, leading to the complete destruction of a high voltage tower and the interruption of the Zahrani-Msayleh line's transmission lines, putting them out of service.

The attacks also resulted in the stations in Tyre, Wadi Jilo, Sultaniyeh, and Taybeh being put out of service, and maintenance work could not have started before an unexploded missile was removed, according to Electricite du Liban.

Israeli drones broadcasting provocative message over border towns in the South

An Israeli march was flying over Adloun and neighboring villages in the Zahrani district while broadcasting [provocative messages](#) against the coordinator of the Southern Border Villages Gathering Tarek Mazraani on Sunday, October 12.

Later in the evening, another drone flew over Nabatieh al-Fawqa with provocative and intimidating messages threatening the return of war to the area.



REPORTING A VIOLATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS TO CLDH

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:

- **WHERE:** City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. what prison)
- **WHAT:** Nature of the violation
- **HOW:** A narrative description of what happened
- **WHEN:** Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)
- **TO WHOM:** Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.
- **WHO** is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.



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
