[Israeli planes cover airspace in the South](#)

Israeli warplanes formed a complete air cover as it was flying over the border regions in the South on Monday, March 31, according to the National News Agency. Israel also dropped a soundbomb between Yarin and Dahra, and fired machine guns at tobacco farmers in the Saasaa area on the outskirts of [Rmeish](#) in Bint Jbeil.

[Israeli forces enter the buffer zone near Tyre and Bent Jbeil](#)

The National News Agency reported that Israeli vehicles were seen entering the Balat position overlooking the towns of Marwahin and Ramba within Israeli-occupied Lebanese territory. This stationing cuts off the main road connecting the Tyre and Bint Jbeil regions near the border town of Marwahin.

Bulldozers were also digging and raising earthen barriers and poles on which surveillance cameras and spy devices were installed on Monday, March 31.

[Israeli airstrike on Beirut kills four and injures 7](#)

An Israeli [airstrike](#) targeted the southern suburbs of Beirut in the early morning hours, targeting the top three floors of a building with two missiles and causing damage to nearby buildings on Tuesday, April 1. The airstrike led to the death of four citizens and the injury of 7 others according to the Ministry of Health.

[Israeli jets drop bombs near Naqoura](#)

Israeli jets were heavily flying in Naqoura at night and dropped several illuminating bombs over Shama and the Labbouneh forests on Tuesday, April 1

[Israeli forces killed a citizen in Adaisseh](#)

Israeli vehicles and bulldozers blocked a [road](#) in Ras al-Naqoura with an earthen berm, and killed one person after opening fire in Adaisseh according to the Health Emergency Operations on Wednesday, April 2.

The National News Agency also reported that an Israeli [reconnaissance plane](#) is flying continuously over villages and towns south of Tyre.

[Syrian refugee tents caught fire in Tyre](#)

A massive fire broke out and destroyed all of the [tents](#) housing Syrian refugees in the Shawakir area, east of Tyre on Wednesday, April 2.

Judge Bitar to resume Beirut Port explosion investigation

A new [investigation](#) phase in the Beirut Port explosion was initiated after judge Tarek Bitar scheduled an interrogation session with the former head of State Security Tony Saliba on Friday, who is currently out of the country, according to local news outlets reports on Thursday, April 3.

Israeli raids and drones on Naqoura and Bint Jbeil

Two Israeli helicopter raids targeted prefabricated rooms in Naqoura on Thursday, April 3, 2025, while three other airstrikes targeted the [Civil Defense](#) center of the Islamic Health Organization with no injuries. Another drone targeted a car in Bint Jbeil and [injured](#) two people.

Israeli airstrike in Saida kills three people

An Israeli [airstrike](#) targeted a residential apartment on Dalaa Street in Saida on the dawn of Friday, April 4 and caused two successive explosions. The airstrike led to the death of three citizens according to the Ministry of Health.

Lebanese Army removes Israeli obstacles placed in Lebanon

Statement issued by The Army Command - Directorate of Orientation on Saturday, April 5:

As part of monitoring the ongoing violations by the Israeli enemy, an army unit in the Alma al-Shaab and Labbouneh areas of Tyre removed engineering obstacles placed by the Israeli enemy to block a road inside Lebanese territory. It also dismantled two explosive devices used by the enemy to booby-trap these obstacles.

The Army Command continues to work to remove enemy violations in close coordination with the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL), while the Israeli enemy continues its attacks on several areas in Lebanon and its violations of the security of the Lebanese people.

Two martyred amidst Israeli airstrikes over border cities

According to various news stations in Lebanon, Israeli airstrikes killed two people in [Zabqin](#) and injured two others in [Beit Leef](#) on Sunday, April 6. Artillery and flare bombs and sound bombs were also thrown over Houla and [Aita Al-Shaab](#), and aircrafts targeted prefabricated houses in [Naqoura](#).

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:

- **WHERE:** City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. what prison)
- **WHAT:** Nature of the violation
- **HOW:** A narrative description of what happened
- **WHEN:** Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)
- **TO WHOM:** Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.
- **WHO** is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
