## LEBANON

### **Heavy Israeli airstrikes on border villages**

Israeli forces conducted heavy strikes on Al-Aishiyeh, Mahmoudiyah, Jarmok, and Khardali stream on Monday, October 20. The attacks caused [explosions](#) that reverberated in the areas of Nabatieh, Marjeyoun, Rayhan and Iqlim al-Tuffah.

Simultaneously, hostile [drones](#) flew over Rashaya Valley and the western slopes of Mount Hermon, reaching the town of Shebaa, and the Lebanese army [removed](#) concrete blocks and earthen barriers set by Israeli forces.

### **Order of Physicians denounce attacks in Sir el-Dinniyeh**

The Order of Physicians denounced the attacks of a citizen on a doctor and nurse in a hospital in Sir el-Dinniyeh on Monday, October 20.

The assault took place last [Friday](#), where the father of a child infected with coronavirus attacked a doctor and a nurse inside Asoun Governmental Hospital after the doctor requested to test his family for COVID-19.

### **Goldfinches intended for smuggling confiscated in Akkar**

Within the framework of the ongoing cooperation between the Ministry of Agriculture and the Lebanese Army Command to protect natural resources and curb the smuggling and illegal trafficking of wildlife, units from the First Land Border Regiment confiscated a group of goldfinches intended for smuggling into Lebanese territory.

[...] The confiscated birds were handed over to the Akkar Agriculture Department in accordance with established legal and administrative procedures, where they were monitored by specialized technical teams.

Goldfinches are a protected species under Lebanese laws and international agreements, due to their environmental and aesthetic importance and their role in ecological balance. Their protection is a national and moral duty that reflects Lebanon's commitment to biodiversity conservation plans and the sustainable management of natural resources.

### [Activists in Amchit stage sit-in to protect endangered monk seal cave](#)

About 20 environmental activists staged a sit-in Tuesday October 21, in Amchit, in the Jbeil district, urging Lebanese authorities to protect what they say is Lebanon's only known breeding cave for the endangered Mediterranean monk seal.

### [Dead body and injured people in Akkar and Anjar](#)

A woman's body was found covered in blood inside her home in the outskirts of Al-Kanisa, Akkar district on Tuesday, October 21, and two people were heavily injured after being stabbed during a robbery in their house. that targeted their home in the town.

### [State security arrested a person for possible communication with Israel](#)

A person was arrested by the State Security on suspicion of communicating with Israel because he was following the Mossad's official page on Facebook.

Simultaneously, an Israeli combing operation with machine guns targeted Khiyam.

### [One person dead in Akkar and one body found in Wadi al-Jamous](#)

One person died after being shot in the face with a hunting rifle while hunting in Akkar Plain on Wednesday, October 22, and a citizen in his thirties was found hanged inside his home in Wadi Al-Jamous.

### [One person killed in Israeli airstrike on Ain Qana](#)

An Israeli airstrike targeted a motorcycle in Ain Qana and killed one person on Wednesday, October 22.

### [ISF arrests members selling frozen dollars](#)

#### **Statement issued by the Public Relations Division - General Directorate of Internal Security Forces on Wednesday, October 22:**

As part of the Internal Security Forces' ongoing efforts to combat theft and fraud in various Lebanese regions, the Information Branch received information about a number of citizens being subjected to fraudulent thefts carried out by unknown individuals who lure their victims by pretending to have "frozen dollars" for sale. Upon meeting the victim, they fraudulently steal their money and then disappear from sight.

Subsequently, orders were given to the relevant units within the branch to conduct field and investigative procedures to identify and arrest the two individuals involved in the aforementioned operations.

During their investigation, they confessed to the charges against them, including their fraudulent execution of the aforementioned thefts. One of these crimes occurred on July 5, 2025, when they fraudulently stole \$3,500 from a money transfer shop in Aley. They also confessed to planning another fraudulent operation in Dahr al-Wahsh, but their arrest prevented it.

### **Five people and two injured in Israeli airstrikes on Arabsalim and Shmastar**

Two people were killed and two others were injured in Israeli airstrikes on Janta and Shmastar on Thursday, October 23, and two others were killed in another airstrike on [Arabsalim](#), according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Simultaneously, heavy Israeli [raids](#) targeted the eastern mountain range, the Shaara, Hermel, and western areas in the Bekaa, while a B7 [missile](#) was fired over the Rashidieh camp and a drone dropped a [bomb](#) in the Marjeyoun plain and caused a fire.

### **Two people injured with gunfire in Badawi and Deniyeh**

One child was injured after being accidentally shot with a hunting rifle in Batarmaz, al-Dinniyeh on Thursday, October 23, while another person also got [injured](#) by gunfire in Jabal al-Badawi.

### **Two killed in Israeli airstrike on Toul and soundbombs on Khiyam**

Two people were killed in an Israeli missile that attacked a car on Toul village road on Friday, October 24, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Simultaneously, an Israeli [soundbomb](#) was dropped on Wadi al-Asafir, near the outskirts of Khiyam, and another [raid](#) targeted Kroum al-Marah neighborhood in Mays al-Jabal with no casualties.

### **One person found dead and another injured in Zouk Mikael and Qanarit**

A Syrian worker fell from a height in Qanarit and sustained multiple fractures on Friday, October 24, and another citizen was found [dead](#) after falling from the roof of a building in Zouk Mikael.

### **Two people killed and one injured in Israeli airstrikes in Qleileh and Jibchit**

One person was killed in an Israeli airstrike that targeted a motorcycle in Qleileh, Tyre District, while another person was killed and another [injured](#) in a car raid on the Harouf-Jibchit road on Saturday, October 25, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Simultaneously, an Israeli soundbomb was dropped near the municipality building in [Blida](#).

### **Multiple people killed and injured in Israeli airstrikes**

Three people were killed by Israeli airstrikes on Naqoura, [Nabi Sheet](#), and [Hafeir al-Fawqa](#), while others sustained injuries in Aitaroun and Hafeir al-Fawqa on Sunday, October 26, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Simultaneously, Israeli forces conducted a combing operation on [Kfrakila](#) and attacked a car in Naqoura, while two [soundbombs](#) dropped on farmers in Aita al-Shaab and a raid targeted an extractor in [Blida](#) at dawn

You can also report an incident anonymously through our [\*\*website\*\*](#).

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:

- **WHERE:** City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. what prison)
- **WHAT:** Nature of the violation
- **HOW:** A narrative description of what happened
- **WHEN:** Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)
- **TO WHOM:** Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.
- **WHO** is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
