### **Three killed and two injured in Israeli airstrikes on Kfarruman and Tyre**

An Israeli airstrike attacked a car in Tyre, killing one person and injuring two others, while another airstrike attacked a truck in Kfarruman and also killed one person on Monday, January 26, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

### **Three people injured by a bomb in Beddawi camp**

The National News Agency reported that three people, including a child, were injured after an unidentified person threw a hand grenade and followed it with gunfire in the air in the Beddawi camp on Monday, January 26.

### **Israeli bombs and gunfire on Markaba and Blida**

Israeli forces opened fire on men working in fields in Yaroun with no injuries reported on Monday, January 26, while machine gun fire was also directed towards the outskirts of Blida in the morning.

Simultaneously, Israeli airstrikes targeted the Aqmata-Louaizeh heights and a house on the outskirts of Aitaroun with two shells, and a soundbomb targeted a marble factory on the Adissa-Markaba road.

### **Lebanon submits complaint to the Security Council on Israeli violations**

#### **Statement issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Emigrants on Monday, January 26:**

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Emigrants, through Lebanon's Permanent Mission to the United Nations in New York, sent a letter to the Security Council and the Secretary-General of the United Nations, containing a complaint regarding the continued Israeli violations of Lebanese sovereignty during the past months.

The complaint included three detailed tables outlining the Israeli violations of Lebanese sovereignty on a daily basis during the months of October, November, and December 2025. The number of these violations reached 542, 691, and 803 respectively, totaling 2,036 violations. The Ministry reiterated that these violations constitute an infringement upon Lebanon's sovereignty and territorial integrity, and a clear breach of Israel's obligations under Security Council Resolution 1701 (2006) of August 11, 2006, and the Declaration of Cessation of Hostilities of November 26, 2004.

### **One killed in Israeli airstrike on Batouliyah**

An Israeli airstrike attacked a motorcycle in Batouliyah, killing one person on Tuesday, January 27, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

### **UNRWA staff protest against salary cuts**

UNRWA staff union led a sit-in protest in front of the agency's office in Tyre on Tuesday, January 27, denouncing their service policies and recent salary cuts.

### **Israeli bombings and soundbombs on Yaroun and Rmeish**

Israeli maneuvers near the Lebanese borders caused loud explosions and flares were noticed over the skies of Yaroun, Rmeish, and Naqoura on Tuesday, January 27. Additionally, two drones dropped explosive devices on a house and artillery shelling targeted Yaroun.

Simultaneously, a stun grenade was dropped near a shepherd on the outskirts of Rmeish and in Aita al-Shaab square, and a bomb landed in the Al-Kasayir neighborhood of Mays al-Jabal.

### **Israeli drones and shells over Yaroun and Ras al-Naqoura**

Two Israeli drones dropped explosive devices towards Yaroun and an explosion occurred in the Sbeih neighborhood east of Houla on Wednesday, January 28.

Simultaneously, a thermal balloon found in Tuffahta was bombed by the Lebanese Army, and two shells fired by Israeli artillery landed off Ras al-Naqoura in the sea.

### **Two people confirmed dead by the building collapse in Tripoli**

The bodies of nurse Alissar Ahmad al-Mir and her father were found dead under the rubble of the collapsed building in Qobbeh, Tripoli on Wednesday, January 28, and the search was ended by the Civil Defense.

### **General Security arrests 4 people at the airport for drug smuggling**

**Statement issued by the Media Office of the General Directorate of General Security on Wednesday, January 28:**

On January 25, 2026, as part of its ongoing monitoring of passenger traffic at border crossings, General Directorate of General Security personnel at Rafik Hariri International Airport apprehended four Turkish nationals (three men and one woman) as they attempted to enter Lebanese territory on a flight arriving from Istanbul.

Following suspicions about their repeated entry and exit, and acting on instructions from the competent judicial authorities, the detainees underwent security investigations. These investigations revealed that they had established an organized network to smuggle narcotics from Turkey to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, in coordination with external parties, in exchange for money. It was also discovered that they had carried out

### **Israeli gunfire near Aitaroun and artillery shells on Ramya**

Israeli forces opened fire towards Aitaroun from their newly established position in Jabal al-Bat inside the Lebanese territory on Thursday, January 29.

Simultaneously, Israeli artillery shells were fired towards al-Salhani area on the outskirts of Ramya and vehicles advanced towards Yaroun and worked to booby-trap a house in the village.

### **Large protests near the Parliament demanding salary increases**

Employees from the public and private sector, particularly security authorities, led protests around the Lebanese Parliament on the evening of Thursday, January 29, demanding an increase in salaries during the draft general budget law session.

Protestors blocked the road in multiple areas in Lebanon including Chtoura, Abassieh, al-Jiyeh, among others.

### **One person killed in Israeli airstrike on Seddiqin**

An Israeli airstrike attacked a car in Sediqin and killed one person on Friday, January 30, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Simultaneously, two people were injured by Israeli raids that targeted a showroom in Daoudieh.

### **Israeli airstrikes and soundbombs across Khiam, Tefahta, and Aita al-Shaab**

Heavy Israeli airstrikes targeted the valleys between Zifta, Al-Numayriyah, Azza, Kfarwa, Al-Musaylih, Tuffahta, and Al-Najjariya on Friday, January 30, and a drone crashed in Raba Thalathin, Marjeyoun district.

Simultaneously, Israeli soundbombs were dropped on the outskirts of Khiam, the outskirts of Aita al-Shaab, and between Markaba and Adaisseh.

### **Environmental breach and destruction of lands in Jbeil**

TERRE Liban reported an environmental breach that has affected lands in Blat, Jbeil district on Friday, January 30.

In a statement, the organization said that “the green cover has been completely destroyed as a result of random cutting of ancient trees, digging of the land, distortion of the natural landscape, and selling the soil to cement factories.”

### **One person killed in Israeli airstrike on Rab Thalathin**

An Israeli airstrike attacked a car in Rab Thalathin and killed one person on Saturday, January 31, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Simultaneously, an Israeli airstrike attacked a car near Barish in Tyre and bombings happened over the Chalets area in Khiam.

### **One killed and multiple injured in Israeli airstrikes on Harouf, Maaroub, and Qnarit**

An Israeli airstrike attacked a car in Harouf and injured six people on Sunday, February 1, in addition to injuring one another on a bulldozer attack in Qnarit using 5 missiles, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Simultaneously, one person was killed and six were injured in Israeli airstrikes on Abba, and one injured in Maaroub.

Israeli forces also conducted a combing operation near the outskirts of Aitaroun and dropped a soundbomb on Aita al-Shaab and threatening leaflets over Bint Jbeil. The forces also invaded Lebanese land and bombed two houses in Rab Thalathin.

## WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details  
(e.g. which prison)



## HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



## TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



## WHAT:

Nature of the violation



## WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



## WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
