Monday 9
February 2026

One person killed in Aita al-Shaab and three others in Yanouh

An Israeli airstrike attacked a car in Yanouh and killed three people, including a child, on Monday, February 9, while another person was also killed by an Israeli sniper in Aita al-Shaab, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli stun grenades and drones in border villages

Five stun grenades attacked Aita al-Shaab, and one grenade on Kfarkila, while "al-Shaqa" area on the outskirts of the town of Aitaroun was targeted on Monday, February 9.

Simultaneously, a drone flew over farmers in the Sarda and Amra area and ordered them to leave.

Tuesday 10
February 2026

One person injured by Israeli soundbomb in Aitaroun

A shepherd sustained injuries after an Israeli soundbomb was thrown over Aitaroun on Tuesday, February 10.

Simultaneously, soundbombs were dropped on Aita al-Shaab and Houla, while artillery fired a shell towards the Sabih neighborhood of Houla and al-Mutayt and al-Shayyar areas between Aitaroun and Blida.

Wednesday
11 February 2026

13 people dead and 8 injured by building collapse in Tripoli

The Public Health Emergency Operations Center announced on Wednesday, February 11, that 13 people were killed and 8 others were injured by the building collapse in Bab al-Tibeneh in Tripoli.

Israeli incursion and drones in Aita al-Shaab and Blida

Israeli forces demolished a house in Blida with drone bombs, after displacing its residents on Wednesday, February 11.

Simultaneously, Israeli incursion and shelling occurred in Aita al-Shaab, in addition to stun grenades dropped on the village.

78 cases of violence against women in January

The National Commission for Lebanese Women and the General Directorate of Internal Security Forces highlighted violence incidents reported to the General Directorate's hotline during January on Wednesday, February 11.

The incidents were distributed as 67 physical violence cases, 11 emotional violence cases, and 0 cases of economic violence, sexual violence, and other types.

**Thursday 12
February 2026**

One person killed in Israeli airstrike on al-Tiri

An Israeli airstrike attacked al-Tiri village in Bint Jbeil and killed one person on Thursday, February 12, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli settlers infiltrate the Lebanese border; artillery shells on Markaba

Israeli settlers stormed the Lebanese border near Yaroun, and started demanding the re-establishment of settlements from Lebanon on Thursday, February 12.

Simultaneously, two artillery shells were fired towards the outskirts of Markaba, while flares were launched over Ras al-Naqaoura and shelling damaged two houses in Yaroun. The Lebanese army also detonated a hostile thermal balloon on the Wata al-Zarariyah-Abba-Ansar road.

**Friday 13
February 2026**

Israeli artillery shells and grenades over border villages

Israeli artillery shelling targeted Wadi Mazlam and gunfire was directed towards Yaroun on Friday, February 13, while another drone dropped two stun grenades towards Aita al-Shaab.

ISF raids two apartments and arrests individuals with weapons and ammunition

Statement issued by the General Directorate of the Internal Security Forces - Public Relations Division on Friday, February 13:

As part of the ongoing efforts of the Internal Security Forces to combat crime, particularly that related to the illicit trafficking of weapons, the Counter-Terrorism and Serious Crimes Bureau in Beirut and Mount Lebanon – Judicial Police Unit – received information indicating the existence of two apartments in the Chiyah area, owned by an individual, which were being used to store, maintain, and traffic weapons.

On January 30, 2026, a force from the Bureau raided the two apartments, resulting in the arrest of five people. During the raid, the following were seized: A quantity of various serviceable rifles and pistols, in addition to disassembled pistols prepared for reloading, various calibers of serviceable ammunition, rifle and pistol magazines, weapon maintenance parts, wooden and antique artifacts, and two motorcycles. Israeli explosives and raids over Jezzine and Mays al-Jabal

An Israeli drone threw explosives over a house in Mays al-Jabal, while a series of raids attacked areas in Jezzine and the outskirts of Houmine al-Fawqa on Saturday, February 14.

Four people killed in Israeli airstrike near Lebanon-Syria border

An Israeli airstrike attacked a car near the Masnaa area on the Lebanese-Syrian border killed four people on Sunday, February 15, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli bombing and infiltration in the South

Israeli airstrikes attacked villages in Iqlim al-Tuffah region and a drone clashed in Houla on Sunday, February 15, while artillery shelling targeted the outskirts of Aitaroun, coinciding with a sweep towards the town's periphery.

Simultaneously, Israeli forces breached the Blue Line and incursed into al-Jidar area in Darb al-Hawrat, and the army bombed an Israeli drone after it crashed outside of Houla.

Two people injured by stray bullets in Karak plain

One person and a child were injured by stray bullets within a tent in Krak plain on Sunday, February 15.

WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details
(e.g. which prison)



HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



WHAT:

Nature of the violation



WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
