## LEBANON

### 12 injured in Israeli airstrike on Ksar Zaatar

An Israeli airstrike targeted the Ksar Zaatar area in Nabatieh injured 12 people on Monday, September 15, including four children and seven women, according to the Public Health's Health Emergency Operations Center.

The Center also announced the injury of one person in an Israeli airstrike on a car in Yater.

### Israeli forces enter Houla; airstrikes on Nabatieh

Israeli forces entered Houla and blew up a building at dawn on Monday, September 15. Flare bombs were dropped over Shebaa, and its outskirts were combed with bullets at night.

Simultaneously, a series of raids attacked Ali al-Taher Heights between Kfar Tibnit and Nabatieh-El-Fawqa

### Strike across UNRWA facilities in Beddawi camp

A general strike and closure of almost all UNRWA facilities in the Beddawi camp took place on Monday, September 15 until further notice.

The strikers stated that this strike was caused by UNRWA's refusal to meet their demands, in addition to numerous decisions by UNRWA in education and school numbers.

### 14 injured in Israeli airstrikes on Nabatieh including children

After heavy Israeli airstrikes on Nabatieh late at night on Monday, 14 citizens of one building were heavily injured on Tuesday, September 16.

Simultaneously, Israeli raids threw soundbombs near a house in Aita al-Shaab and flare bombs over Wazzani, and a combing operation used heavy machine guns towards Hamames.

## Bulgaria arrests boat owner connected to Beirut Port explosion

According to AFP, Bulgarian authorities arrested Russian national Igor Grechushkin, owner of the Rhosus cargo ship linked to the 2020 Beirut port explosion in the airport on Tuesday, September 16.

The arrest comes after five years of an [Interpol](#) arrest warrant issued against him and the captain of the ship.

## State Security seizes unlicensed beauty center and arrests the owner

**Statement issued by The General Directorate of State Security – Media, Guidance, and Public Relations Division on Tuesday, September 16:**

In continuation of its mission to monitor health violations, a patrol from the Northern Regional Directorate – Minieh-Dinnieh Office raided a beauty center in the Bhanine area on September 5, 2025. It was found that the man was operating without a professional license or an official license for the center.

The raid also seized quantities of expired and unknown-source medications, as well as cosmetics, Botox injections, and a plasma device.

The center's owner was arrested and handed over, along with the seized items, to the relevant authorities, pursuant to a warrant from the competent judiciary.

### Four killed in Israeli airstrike on Baalbek

Two people were killed in an Israeli airstrike on a car in Baalbek city on Wednesday, September 17, and two others were killed in a [raid](#) on the Asira area of Baalbek.

Simultaneously, Israeli forces bombed a house on the outskirts of [Aita al-Shaab](#), and threw [flare shells](#) between Mays al-Jabal and Houla and an incendiary [bomb](#) between Kfar Kila and Deir Mimas.

### Ghazieh municipality arrests a person for inappropriate behavior

The Ghazieh Municipal Police arrested a [resident](#) of the Zanbil neighborhood, after receiving complaints of his inappropriate behavior toward a number of girls on Wednesday, September 17.

### Container collapse near Beirut port and an appeal to the Ministry of Public Works

The YASA Association issued an urgent appeal to the Ministry of Public Works and the Beirut Port Authority after the collapse of a container in the port on Wednesday, September 17.

The appeal called for measures to ensure traffic safety within the port, and emphasized the need to adopt clear plans that include adherence to truck quality specifications and the safety standards required.

## **Two people injured by Israeli airstrikes in Mays al-Jabal and Naqoura**

According to the Public Health's Health Emergency Operations Center, one person was injured by one of the multiple Israeli airstrikes on Mays al-Jabal on Thursday, September 18.

A [fisherman](#) also sustained minor injuries from soundbombs dropped on Naqoura Port at least three times.

## **Israeli forces issue evacuation warnings for 3 villages and conduct heavy airstrikes**

Israeli army [spokesperson](#) issued a warning to evacuate buildings in Mays al-Jabal, Tebnin, and Kfartebnin on Thursday, September 18. It destroyed a house in Kfartebnin and damaged others nearby.

Simultaneously, heavy Israeli raids targeted Dibbin, [Burj Qalawi](#), Shehabiyeh, and Shebaa, and dropped soundbombs on the port of Naqoura, [Yarin](#), Labbounah, outskirts of Adaisseh. A machine gun combing operation was also carried out towards the outskirts of [Khiyam](#).

## **Lebanese Army condemns continued Israeli violations in Lebanon**

### **Statement issued by The Army Command - Directorate of Orientation on Thursday, September 18:**

The Israeli enemy continues its violations, exceeding 4,500 since the cessation of hostilities agreement entered into force [...]

In this context, the Israeli enemy continues its attacks against civilians, the latest of which was the targeting of a number of southern villages today, in addition to civilians in several populated areas, resulting in deaths and injuries. This coincides with its persistent violations of Lebanese sovereignty by land, sea, and air, and its ongoing crimes against residents of border villages, including the launching of Molotov cocktails and the detonation of houses.

These attacks and violations are hindering the army's deployment in the south, and their continuation will hinder the implementation of its plan, starting from the area south of the Litani River.

As part of the ongoing engineering survey operations in the southern regions, a specialized military unit discovered and dismantled a camouflaged spy device placed by the Israeli enemy in the Labbounah-Tyre area. [...]

## **Two killed in Israeli airstrikes on Tebnin and Ansar, others injured**

One person was killed and 11 others were injured in an Israeli airstrike on a car in Tebnin on Friday, September 19, while another person was killed in a raid on [Ansar](#).

Simultaneously, Israeli helicopters threw incendiary bombs on the [Jabal al-Rafi'](#) area, causing a large forest fire. Israel also dropped two [soundbombs](#) between Markaba and Adaisseh and two illuminating shells towards [Yaroun](#) forest.

## **Newborn baby dead body found in Keserwan**

The body of a newborn baby was found [dumped](#) on the main road in the town of Raashin - Keserwan on Friday, September 19.

### One killed in Israeli airstrike on al-Khardali road

An Israeli airstrike targeted a "Rapid" at the Ain Al-Qasab bend on Al-Khardali Road, killing one citizen and causing a fire on Saturday, September 20.

Simultaneously, two Israeli soundbombs fell near an excavator in [Khiyam](#), and Israeli drones dropped warning [leaflets](#) in Mays al-Jabal.

### Bus driver stabbed in Rabieh; doctor and secretary killed in Adloun

A doctor was [attacked](#) along with his secretary in Adloun on Saturday, September 20, after he requested from a person parked in front of his clinic to move. They were deliberately hit with his car once and he attempted to repeat it again.

Additionally, a passenger bus driver was brutally stabbed and [killed](#) by unknown perpetrators that fled the scene in Rabieh.

### A family of five killed in Israeli airstrikes on Bint Jbeil

Three people from the same family were killed after an Israeli airstrike attacked a motorcycle near their car in Bint Jbeil on Sunday, September 21, and two other family members remain injured.

Simultaneously, an Israeli drone dropped [incendiary](#) bombs on the Jabal al-Rafi' forests, and forces penetrated [Ramyeh](#) at night and blew up a house.

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:

- **WHERE:** City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. what prison)
- **WHAT:** Nature of the violation
- **HOW:** A narrative description of what happened
- **WHEN:** Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)
- **TO WHOM:** Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.
- **WHO** is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
