LEBANON

Monday
23 June 2025

Tens of Israeli airstrikes in border areas

In one of its heaviest attacks, a series of raids targeted al-Zarariyah, Kafr Melki, Tebna area in al-Bissariya, and Ansar in the South on Monday, June 23. Two raids targeted Kafr Melki and Barta, and three more targeted Hawrata al-Tahta, al-Mahmoudiya, and al-Wardiya.

A family was also targeted by an Israeli soundbomb while checking their destroyed home in Khallet Wardeh - Aita al-Shaab, but no injuries were recorded.

Israeli airstrikes cause fires in Azza and Majdal Slim

A fire broke out between Majdal Silm and Khirbet Silm after remains of an interceptor missile fell over the area on Monday, June 23. Israeli raids also caused a large fire between Kafrwa, Azza and Zefta.

24 June 2025

Three killed in an airstrike on Kfardjal

An Israeli airstrike targeted a car on the road in Kfardjal and killed three citizens in the car on Tuesday, June 24.

Simultaneously, an Israeli airstrike fell over Markaba in Marjayoun district.

Lebanese Army arrests ISIS leader

Statement issued by The Army Command - Directorate of Orientation on Tuesday, June 24:

After a series of security surveillance and follow-up operations, the Intelligence Directorate arrested citizen (R.F.), one of the most prominent leaders of the terrorist ISIS organization, who also participated in planning security operations.

A large quantity of weapons and ammunition, as well as electronic devices and equipment for manufacturing drones, were seized in his possession. The detainee had assumed leadership of the organization in Lebanon following the arrest of his predecessor [...].

Wednesday
25 June 2025

Two citizens injured by Israeli airstrikes

A citizen was injured by a bomb fired from an Israeli plane in [Mansouri](#) on Wednesday, June 25, and another citizen was also injured by the explosion of an Israeli shell left behind in Rab Thalatheen.

Israeli forces open fire at truck in Mays al-Jabal

Israeli forces fired on a truck in Mays al-Jabal in the morning of Wednesday, June 25, with no injuries recorded. The patrol later threw two [bombs](#) into the car after crossing the Blue Line at noon.

The bombs created a fire that spread to the exterior of the truck, and the Lebanese Army initiated a series of contacts to secure immediate access to the truck and remove it from the site.

ISF intercepts drug smuggling attempts outside Lebanon

Statement issued by General Directorate of Internal Security Forces - Public Relations Division on Wednesday, June 25, 2025:

As part of the ongoing efforts of the Internal Security Forces to combat drug smuggling operations, and as a result of the follow-up efforts of the relevant units, members of the Airport Inspection Division of the Airport Company/Embassy, Administrations, and Public Institutions Security Unit were able to arrest a citizen while attempting to smuggle a quantity of drugs hidden in her clothing to an Arab country [...]

As a result of the investigations and information gathering, it was revealed that the arrested woman was active in a drug smuggling network from Lebanon to an Arab country. [...]

Thursday
26 June 2025

Two people killed in Beit Leef and Shaqra in Israeli airstrikes

One citizen was killed after an Israeli airstrike attacked a [motorcycle](#) on Beit Leef after suffering from his injuries on Thursday, June 26.

Another citizen died from his injuries after an Israeli airstrike targeted his bulldozer between [Shaqra](#) and Barashit in the morning.

Israeli forces conducted a bombing in Jabal Blat

Israeli forces carried out an explosion in the vicinity of Jabal Blat, opposite the towns of Marwahin and Ramya on Thursday, June 26.

Simultaneously, an Israeli drone dropped a [bomb](#) in Al-Shawat neighborhood in Aita al-Shaab.

Friday

27 June 2025

One killed and 21 injured in Nabatieh, 4 injured in Shaqr

In one of its heaviest attack days, Israeli airplanes launched a belt of fire on Nabatieh, targeting Ali al-Taher forests, Kfartibnit heights, and al-Nabatiyeh al-Fawqa with more than 20 airstrikes in the morning hours of Friday, June 27.

This heavy attack led to the death of one citizen, after an Israeli drone targeted her apartment with a guided missile, and injured 21 others.

Later, an Israeli airstrike on Shaqra targeted a house and injured four citizens from the village.

Israel threatened to attack three houses in Khiam

Israeli forces threatened to bomb three houses in the southern neighborhood of Khiam, Nabatieh, that they had previously rigged with explosives on Friday, June 27.

Throughout the day, two Israeli raids targeted Zrarieh and Ansar villages, and another drone dropped a sound bomb with two metal loading vehicles in Ramya and no injuries were recorded.

Lebanese Army intercepts attempts to smuggle missiles into Lebanon

Statement issued by the Army Command - Directorate of Orientation on Friday, June 27:

On June 26, 2025, a patrol from the Intelligence Directorate thwarted an attempt to smuggle shells and missiles from Syria into Lebanon in the Bsaibes-Hermel area, seizing a quantity of them.

The seized items were handed over, and investigations are underway to arrest those involved.

Saturday and Sunday

Three killed and other wounded in Israeli airstrikes on Mahrouna and Kunin

An Israeli airstrike attacked a motorcycle in Mahrouna, Tyre district, killing two citizens and injuring two others on Saturday, June 28. One of the citizens was killed after their car hit a concrete barrier as a result of the raid.

In Kunin, one citizen was killed and another was wounded by an Israeli airstrike that targeted a car.

UNIFIL patrol intercepted in Ibl al-Saqi

According to the National News Agency, residents of Tal Ebel in Ibl el-Saqi intercepted a UNIFIL patrol since it was not escorted by the Lebanese Army on Saturday, June 28.

The town's mayor and other residents condemned the attack, stating that "this incident is completely contrary to the peaceful principles and ethics of the residents".

Israeli missile on Aita al-Shaab and an airstrike on Ramya

An Israeli raid attacked a house in Ramya, Bint Jbeil, while another airplane targeted a house in Aita al-Shaab with a guided missile, and no injuries were recorded on Sunday, June 29.

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:

- **WHERE:** City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. what prison)
- **WHAT:** Nature of the violation
- **HOW:** A narrative description of what happened
- **WHEN:** Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)
- **TO WHOM:** Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.
- **WHO** is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
