Monday 30
March 2026

One killed and multiple injured in Israeli airstrike on Dahyeh

One person was killed and 17 others were injured, including four kids, in an Israeli airstrike on Rihab area in Dahyeh, Beirut, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes hit Srifa, Sahmar, and multiple southern towns

Israeli airstrikes struck Srifa, the Ibl al-Saqi–Jdeideh–Khiyam junction, Jibchit, Sahmar and its surroundings, Rshaf, the outskirts of Haris and Kafra, al-Sawaneh, Nabatieh, Qabrikha, Hanine, al-Mansouri, Yater, Bint Jbeil, Aita al-Shaab, Beirut's southern suburbs, Hannawe, and Deir Aames on Monday, March 30.

Artillery shelling targeted the northern entrance of al-Khiyam, Arid Marjayoun, and the outskirts of al-Samaaiyeh, while a UNIFIL patrol was targeted on the Bani Hayan–Tallousa road, prompting helicopter intervention from Naqoura to evacuate the wounded.

Tuesday 31
March 2026

Casualties reported in al-Najjariyeh and Srifa

An Israeli airstrike on al-Najjariyeh in the Sidon district resulted in the killing of four people, including two women on Tuesday, March 31. In Srifa, an Israeli airstrike led to the killing of three people and the injury of 19 others, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes hit Majdal Zoun, Shmistar, and coastal areas

Israeli airstrikes struck Majdal Zoun, Kfardounin, Barish, areas between al-Shahabiyeh and Sela, areas between al-Daouiyyeh and al-Msaileh, Mashghara, Srifa, Tuffahata, Sahl al-Brak, Tabna, Shmistar, areas between Sahmar and Yahmar, al-Hanniyeh, and areas between al-Shahabiyeh and Kfardounin on Tuesday, March 31. Additional strikes targeted a vehicle on the Khaldeh highway and multiple areas along the Zahrani coast.

Artillery shelling targeted al-Hanniyeh, al-Qleileh, Zibqin, Jbal al-Botm, the eastern neighborhood of al-Khiyam, the outskirts of Naqoura and al-Bayyada, al-Ghandouriyeh, Frun, and al-Mansouri, alongside intermittent shelling and the use of illumination flares over areas between Marwahin and Ramyeh.

Wednesday
1 April 2026

Casualties reported in Jnah and Houmine al-Tahta

An Israeli airstrike on the Jnah area in Beirut resulted in seven fatalities and 26 injuries on Wednesday, April 1. In Houmine al-Tahta, four members of the same family were killed in an airstrike on their home, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes and shelling target Nabatieh, Tyre, and Bint Jbeil areas

Israeli airstrikes struck Aaramta, al-Rihan, Frun, al-Jmeijmeh, Haddatha, Qlaouiyeh, Safad al-Battikh, Braachit, Mifdoun, areas near Bint Jbeil Governmental Hospital, Kafra, Haris, al-Mansouri, Hanine, and areas between al-Dweir and al-Kfour on Wednesday, April 1. Additional strikes targeted multiple towns in Nabatieh and Marjayoun, alongside drone strikes on a van and a car near the Green City on the Maarka road, causing disruptions.

Artillery shelling targeted villages in Tyre, Wadi al-Hujeir, al-Hanniyeh, al-Qleileh, al-Mansouri, Zawtar al-Sharqiyeh, and Maroun al-Ras, alongside intermittent shelling across multiple areas and intense aerial activity over Tyre and Jezzine.

UNESCO places 39 cultural properties under enhanced protection

Statement issued by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization on Wednesday, April 1:

UNESCO today convened an extraordinary meeting to strengthen the protection of cultural heritage in Lebanon, following the country's request. The meeting - an extraordinary session of the Committee for the Protection of Cultural Property in the Event of Armed Conflict – led to granting provisional enhanced protection to 39 cultural properties as well as the provision of an international financial assistance, totaling over 100,000USD for emergency operations on the ground. This emergency initiative complements the action already undertaken by UNESCO in recent weeks to protect cultural heritage in impacted countries in the Middle East. Since the outbreak of hostilities, UNESCO has been working closely with the Ministry of Culture and the Directorate General of Antiquities in Lebanon to support the secure storage of archeological collections and museums.

Thursday 2
April 2026

Fatalities reported in al-Ramadiyeh and Zbdine

Four people were killed and three others were injured in al-Ramadiyeh on Thursday, April 2. In Zbdine, three members of the same family were killed in an airstrike on their home, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes hit Kafra, Bint Jbeil, and Nabatieh areas

Israeli airstrikes struck areas between Kafra and Srebbine, Toul, Burj Qalaway, al-Jmeijmeh, Bint Jbeil, Haboush, Tebnine, al-Sultaniyah, Kfardounin, Aita al-Jabal, Blat, al-Mansouri, Zawtar al-Sharqiyeh, the Dardara–Khiyam road, al-Jallahiyyeh, and Debbine on Thursday, April 2.

Artillery shelling targeted al-Khiyam, Siddiqine, Jbal al-Botm, and Zibqin, while widespread explosions and demolitions of homes and infrastructure were reported overnight in Naqoura, al-Bayyada, and the outskirts of Dhayra.

Friday 3
April 2026

Two killed and 15 injured by Israeli airstrike on Sahmar

An Israeli airstrike on Sahmar in the Western Bekaa, carried out as worshippers were leaving the town's mosque, resulted in the killing of two people and the injury of 15 others, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes hit Sahmar, Nabatieh, and Tyre areas

Israeli airstrikes struck Sahmar, destroying the bridge linking it to Mashghara, alongside additional strikes on Debbine, the Maarka–industrial city road in Tyre, Kfarsir, Deir al-Zahrani, Qlaouiyyeh, Srifa, Nabatieh al-Fawqa, Safad al-Battikh, al-Ramadiyyeh, Ansar, Dahyeh, and al-Bustan on Friday, April 3. Additional strikes targeted villages across Tyre overnight, while demolitions of remaining homes were reported in Aita al-Shaab.

Saturday & Sunday
4 & 5
April 2026

Multiple casualties reported in Maarka, al-Housh, and Haboush

Five people were killed, including a woman, and one person was injured in Maarka on Saturday, April 4. In al-Housh, Tyre district, two airstrikes resulted in 18 injuries, including a child, three women, and three paramedics. In Haboush, two girls were killed and 22 people were injured, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes hit Frun, Bint Jbeil, and Nabatieh areas

Israeli airstrikes struck Frun, the outskirts of Ibl al-Saqi, Kfarsir, al-Shahabiyeh, al-Dweir, Braachit, Yater, Majdal Selm, al-Majadel, Deir Qanoun, Ras al-Ain, Kafra, Kfariouz, Mashghara, Bint Jbeil, Burj Qalaway, Kfardounin, al-Hammadiyyeh, Maarka junction, al-Kharaeb, Deir Antar, areas between Beit Yahoun and Braachit, Burj al-Shamali, Qana, Batouliyyeh, Sajd, al-Khiyam, Debbine, Deir Mimas, Tebnine, and the fishermen's port on Saturday, April 4.

Additional strikes targeted a café near Qaraoun Lake, a threatened building at Maarka junction, and vehicles in Burj al-Shamali and along the Bazourieh road.

Artillery and phosphorus shelling targeted al-Azziyyeh in Deir Mimas and al-Jallahiyyeh in al-Khiyam, alongside shelling of villages across southern Tyre and multiple areas in Nabatieh, with explosions also reported.

Multiple people killed in Jnah and Kfarhata by Israeli airstrikes

Four people were killed and 39 others were injured in an Israeli airstrike on Jnah, while seven people, including a four-year-old girl, were killed in an Israeli airstrike on Kfarhata on Sunday, April 5, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes hit Aabba, Safad al-Battikh, and Beirut suburbs

Israeli airstrikes struck Safad al-Battikh, Aabba, al-Ghandouriyeh, al-Dweir, Toul, Srifa, al-Shahabiyeh, Siddiqine, Maaroub, Jwaya, Mahrouna, Yanooh, Qabrikha, al-Taybeh, al-Qleileh, al-Shaaityeh, al-Qasmiyeh, Deir Qanoun al-Nahr, al-Abbassiyeh, al-Bazourieh, and Aitit on Sunday, April 5. Additional strikes targeted areas between Tayr Debba and Maarka, near the highway bridge in al-Qasmiyeh, and Dahyeh, including Ghobeiry and al-Jamous, with at least eight airstrikes reported.

Artillery shelling targeted Arid Marjayoun, Khiraj al-Habbariyeh, Tebnine, al-Hanniyeh, Jbal al-Botm, Zibqin, and al-Housh, alongside shelling of multiple villages in Nabatieh.

WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details
(e.g. which prison)



HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



WHAT:

Nature of the violation



WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
