4 August 2025

National March in Beirut in fifth memory of Beirut Port explosion

Thousands of Lebanese citizens and residents gathered in Beirut near the port area in commemoration of the fifth memory of the Beirut port explosion on Monday, August 4.

According to Minister of Justice [Adel Nassar](#), investigations in the Beirut port explosion are close to being completed by Judge Tarek Bitar in preparation for issuing the indictment.

One killed and four injured in Israeli airstrike on Khiam

An Israeli airstrike targeted a house in the town of [Khiam](#), killing one citizen and injuring four others on Monday, August 4.

Simultaneously, Israeli artillery [shelled](#) the area between Maroun al-Ras and Yaroun, and bombarded Ramya and Aita al-Shaab villages with [artillery](#) and sound bombs.

Lebanese Army finds Israeli spy device and drone in Bint Jbeil

Statement issued by The Army Command - Directorate of Orientation on Monday, August 4:

On August 4, 2025, as part of its ongoing engineering survey operations in the southern regions, a specialized military unit discovered a camouflaged spy device equipped with a camera and two Israeli drones in the outskirts of Aitaroun, Bint Jbeil. The unit inspected and dismantled them.

Tuesday
5 August 2025

One killed in Israeli airstrike on Brital

An Israeli airstrike targeted a car in Brital, killing its driver on Tuesday, August 5, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Simultaneously, Israeli drones dropped two [soundbombs](#) over Kroum al-Sharqi neighborhood and al-Kasayer neighborhood in Mays al-Jabal respectively.

Wednesday
6 August 2025

Citizen killed by unknown people in the South

A young man from Burj Rahal was shot and [killed](#) by unknown people on the Toura-Abbasiya road on Tuesday, August 5.

ISF arrests drug dealer with large drug quantity in Sin El Fil

Statement issued by The Public Relations Division of the Internal Security Forces General Directorate on Tuesday, August 5:

As part of the Internal Security Forces' daily monitoring of drug trafficking operations across various Lebanese regions, the Information Division received information regarding the activity of a certain individual in this field, particularly in the Mount Lebanon and Metn regions.

Immediately, the Division's specialized units began their investigations, and as a result of extensive investigations and inquiries, they were able to identify the individual and arrest him red-handed in the Sin el-Fil area while he was trafficking drugs in a car which was subsequently seized. During interrogation, he admitted to distributing drugs to a number of customers [...]

Two people killed and others injured in Israeli airstrikes on Tulin and Deir Siryan

An Israeli airstrike targeted a house in the town of [Tulin](#), killing an 11-year-old child and injuring his father on Wednesday, August 6. Another citizen was killed and two more were injured in heavy airstrikes on [Deir Siryan](#) at night.

Simultaneously, Israeli forces threw provocative [leaflets](#) at Baraka Square in Mays al-Jabal, according to the National News Agency.

Tens of Israeli airstrikes on border villages in South

In a heavy attack, a series of Israeli airstrikes targeted Yahmar Al-Shaqif, Adshit Al-Qasir, Al-Qantara, Ansar and Al-Mahmoudiya villages on Wednesday, August 6 during late night hours. A minimum of five consecutive [airstrikes](#) attacked Deir Siryan, targeting vehicles and bulldozers and leading to casualties.

Simultaneously, an Israeli drone dropped two soundbombs in [Khiam](#), another soundbomb in [Yaroun](#), and four bombs over Al-Wazzani.

Disputes in Zahle and Tyre lead to murder and injuries

A man was killed in Zahle after a fight with another person over the disappearance of gold artifacts that they both found in one of the mountains on Wednesday, August 6. His body was hidden near a hotel, and the ISF retrieved it and began investigations.

Simultaneously, another dispute during a football match in [Tyre](#) injured two Lebanese Army officers and injured another ISF officer after they were stabbed, and the perpetrators fled to an unknown location.

Ministry of Agriculture confiscates firewood from Harrar Forests in Akkar

Statement issued by the Ministry of Agriculture on Wednesday, August 6:

The Akkar Agriculture Department, acting on a citizen complaint, inspected a forest site in the town of Harrar, where it was discovered that illegal tree felling was taking place.

A team from the Rural Development Department headed to the site and conducted a thorough field inspection, which resulted in the seizure of a quantity of cut firewood, in addition to the confiscation of saws and equipment used in illegal felling.

The Akkar Agriculture Department emphasized the importance of citizens' adherence to applicable laws and regulations, emphasizing that any encroachment on forest resources constitutes an environmental crime punishable by law, and that it will not be tolerated.

Six killed and ten injured in Israeli airstrike on Masnaa

An Israeli airstrike targeted a car on the Masnaa road near the Lebanese-Syrian borders on Thursday, August 7 according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center updates on Friday. Another citizen was killed in an Israeli airstrike on a car in [Kfardan](#), Baalbek district.

Simultaneously, an Israeli drone dropped three soundbombs on the outskirts of [Wazzani](#).

Lebanese army arrests three citizens that assaulted officers

Statement issued by The Army Command - Directorate of Orientation on Thursday, August 7:

On August 6, 2025, as part of the pursuit of those involved in the assault on Army and General Directorate of Public Security officers, who were injured in Tyre, the Intelligence Directorate arrested citizens for their involvement in the assault.

An Army unit, supported by a patrol from the aforementioned directorate, raided the home of another in al-Hawsh area of Tyre for collaborating with wanted individuals and assisting their escape. A quantity of weapons, ammunition, and military equipment was seized in his possession. The seized items were handed over, and an investigation was initiated with the detainees under the supervision of the competent judiciary.

Nursery closed in Tyre for not meeting health standards

Employees from the Tyre District Medical Department at the Ministry of Health closed a nursery in the Burj al-Shamali area in Tyre on Thursday, August 7, after violations of health and safety requirements needed to ensure child safety.

Friday
8 August 2025

One killed in Israeli airstrike on Zahrani

Journalist Mohammed Shehadeh was [killed](#) in an Israeli airstrike on his car driving on Zahrani Road on Friday, August 8.

Simultaneously, [leaflets](#) were dropped from an Israeli drone over Aitaroun taking accountability for attacking a civilian vehicle.

Saturday and Sunday

Israeli airstrike targets Civil Defense stopping a fire; Drones drop soundbombs

An Israeli drone dropped two incendiary bombs between Al-Jbeen and Yarbin on Friday, August 8, and caused a large fire.

Another drone threw a guided missile on civil defense members to stop them from extinguishing the fire, but no injuries were reported.

Simultaneously, Israeli drones threw two soundbombs near [Rmeish](#) with no casualties caused, and dropped a guided missile on a bulldozer on the outskirts of [Aitaroun](#).

State Security seizes spoiled food in Tripoli

Statement issued by The General Directorate of State Security – Media, Guidance, and Public Relations Department on Friday, August 8:

As part of its ongoing efforts to protect food security, a patrol from the Northern Regional Directorate – Tripoli Office of State Security raided a food warehouse in the Mina neighborhood of Tripoli, owned by a Lebanese national (M.M.).

Quantities of expired food were seized inside. The warehouse was sealed with red wax, and legal action was taken against the warehouse owner, pursuant to a court order.

Six Lebanese army officers killed and others injured in explosion in Tyre

The Lebanese Army announced the [death](#) of six of its officers and others wounded in an explosion of a weapons depot in Wadi Zebqin - Tyre on Saturday, August 9, while the officers were dismantling the weapons from the location.

One killed in Israeli airstrike on Ainata

An Israeli airstrike targeted a [car](#) in between Aitaroun and Ainata and killed one person on Saturday, August 9.

One person injured in Israeli airstrike on Mayfadoun

An Israeli drone strike on [Mayfadoun](#), Nabatieh district resulted in minor injuries to one person on Sunday, August 10.

Simultaneously, Israeli artillery shelling and incendiary [shells](#) targeted Ramya and Beit Lif, setting forests ablaze, and an Israeli drone [crashed](#) in Maroun al-Ras.

Large fire in Kfardebian kills three people

A warehouse containing fuel tanks caught fire in the Faqra-Kfardebian area, causing a large fire that [killed](#) three people and injured six others on Sunday, August 10.

Multiple citizens killed in personal conflicts around Lebanon

A dispute between two families in Jiroun, Danniyeh, escalated into a clash using handguns, killing two people and injuring others on Sunday, August 10.

Simultaneously, a citizen was [killed](#) after a person fired nine bullets at him in Barja, Chouf district, and the killer was able to escape.

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:

- **WHERE:** City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. what prison)
- **WHAT:** Nature of the violation
- **HOW:** A narrative description of what happened
- **WHEN:** Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)
- **TO WHOM:** Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.
- **WHO** is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
