Monday 2
March 2026

Israeli strikes intensify across southern Lebanon and southern suburbs of Beirut

Israeli tank fire and airstrikes struck multiple towns and villages across southern Lebanon and the southern suburbs of Beirut on Monday, March 2. A Merkava tank shelled Khiyam, while airstrikes targeted a home in Arbsalim, the entrance of Shahour, Kfar Melki, and Kfar Tebnit. Intense raids hit the southern suburbs of Beirut, including at least four separate airstrikes, while artillery shelling struck the outskirts of Maroun al-Ras.

Additional airstrikes targeted Bint Jbeil, Salha, the outskirts of Dbaal and Maarakeh, and Hosh al-Rafqa west of Baalbek. A series of raids also hit several towns in the Tyre district, while airstrikes struck Qana, Sha'itiyeh, Al-Sama'iyah, al-Heniyeh, and the Batm mountains.

Human Rights Watch warns civilians at grave risk amid Israeli war

Statement issued by the Human Rights Watch on Monday, March 2:

In the early hours of March 2, 2026, Hezbollah fired rockets and drones into northern Israel, after which the Israeli military carried over 70 strikes across Lebanon, including on southern and eastern Lebanon as well as Beirut's southern suburbs, killing at least 52 people, injuring at least 154 people, and displacing tens of thousands of people, according to Lebanon's Ministry of Social Affairs. No casualties were reported from the Hezbollah rockets fired toward northern Israel.

Since October 7, 2023, Israeli forces have committed numerous violations of the laws of war in Lebanon with total impunity, including apparently deliberate or indiscriminate attacks on journalists, civilians, medics, financial institutions, reconstruction-related facilities, and peacekeepers, in addition to the widespread and unlawful use of white phosphorus in populated areas, among other violations. [...]

Warnings that do not give civilians adequate time to leave for a safer area would not be considered "effective" under the law. Broad warnings unrelated to any imminent attack cannot be considered "effective" and may instead improperly instill fear in the affected population.

Customary international law prohibits "acts or threats of violence the primary purpose of which is to spread terror among the civilian population." Statements that call for evacuating areas that are primarily intended to cause panic among residents or compel them to leave their homes for reasons other than their safety would fall under this prohibition.

Tuesday 3
March 2026

Multiple people killed in Qabrikha, Aramoun by Israeli airstrikes

Six people were killed and 8 others were injured in Israeli airstrikes on Aramoun and Saadaiyat, while two people were also killed and two others were injured by an Israeli airstrike on a motorcycle in Qabrikha on Tuesday, March 3

This raises the total number to 50 deaths and 335 injuries, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

Israeli airstrikes and artillery target southern Lebanon and border areas

Israeli raids struck Qana and Kfardounin and Bir al-Salasil, while other strikes targeted Zarariyah and Sarafand on Tuesday, March 3. Intermittent shelling struck Ras Naqoura, Khiyam, and the outskirts of Labouneh. Additional airstrikes targeted al-Saksikiyah, Anqoun, Debbine, Bnaffoul in Zahrani, Yahmar al-Shaqif, and Mansouri.

A violent strike hit the Ksar Zaatar neighborhood in Nabatieh city, and artillery fire also targeted villages in Bint Jbeil, Aita al-Shaab, and Ramieh. Raids struck Shbeil and the surroundings of Sarira, as well as the outskirts of Tarfalsiyah and Sidqine. Additional strikes hit Shahour, the Litani riverbanks in the Tairfalsiyah area, and Labouneh outskirts near Naqoura. A raid targeted a room in Jibshit, and Israeli forces also struck a house in Deir Mimas with artillery fire.

Wednesday
4 March 2026

72 killed and multiple injured by Israeli airstrikes on Lebanon

According to the Health Emergency Operations Center, two airstrikes on the Airport Road killed 3 people and injured 6. The overall toll of the expanded aggression has risen to 72 dead and 437 injured as of Wednesday, March 4.

Israeli airstrikes and artillery attacks across southern Lebanon and southern suburbs of Beirut

Israeli airstrikes and artillery shelling targeted multiple towns and districts in southern Lebanon and the southern suburbs of Beirut on Wednesday, March 5. Strikes hit Choueifat near the Ghandoor factory, violent early-morning raids struck the southern suburbs, and intense airstrikes targeted Qobayrikha. In Nabatieh, a second Israeli air assault destroyed an eight-story residential building. Additional strikes hit Haddatha, Braishit, Dair 'Ammis, and two airstrikes targeted Khirbet Selm.

A series of violent raids targeted the Saraya area in Nabatieh and the Bir al-Qandeel neighborhood, while other strikes hit the area between Bedyas and Burj Rahal, Harouf, and Wadi Karim between Sidqine and Kfra, as well as Yater-Ramieh. Artillery fire struck Aita al-Shaab, Qawzah, Beit Lif, and Majdal, while Israeli incursions and shelling affected Khiyam. Additional airstrikes targeted the outskirts of Arzoun and Shahour, Suwayri and Mahmoudieh in the Jezzine region, Haret Hreik, and the southern suburbs, with Israeli forces advancing toward the outskirts of Kfarchouba – Rbaa al-Tebn.

Thursday 5
January 2026

Israeli strikes cause multiple casualties in Lebanon

The total toll of the ongoing Israeli aggression rose to 123 killed and 683 injured on Thursday, March 5, after two people were killed and three others injured in an Israel airstrike in Labaya, while four people, including two children, were killed in an airstrike on Mashghara.

In Al-Baddawi camp in Tripoli, two people were killed and one woman was injured following an airstrike targeting an apartment in the area.

Israeli airstrikes and shelling across multiple villages in southern Lebanon

Israeli raids targeted Khiam, the area between Brital and Taybeh in the Bekaa, and the southern suburbs of Beirut, including a series of five airstrikes and a violent strike on Haret Hreik on Thursday, March 5. Additional strikes hit Kharayeb in the Zahrani district, Ghobeiry in the southern suburbs, Shaqra, Yater and Beit Lif with artillery fire, the Rihan Heights and Nabatieh, cutting the road toward Nabatieh al-Fawqa and Kfar Tebnit.

Sidqine, Qaakqaia al-Jisr, and the area between Tebnine and Safad al-Battikh were also hit, along with Qulayla, Kfar Tebnit, and the vicinity of the Traffic Department in Nabatieh. Additional raids targeted Toulin, Taloussa, and the outskirts of Dair Sirian and al-Adaisseh. Heavy shelling affected the Litani riverbed and outskirts of Sarira, and partial destruction was reported at the Rahal bakery building on the Toul – Dweir road. A large-scale combing operation with small arms took place in Kfarkila, and the Tyre district medical center sustained damage from previous strikes.

Friday 6
March 2026

Hundreds of casualties across southern Lebanon from Israeli strikes

According to health authorities, an initial toll from an airstrike on Saida left 5 people dead and 7 injured on Friday, March 6. In Nabi Sheet, multiple airstrikes, including the 12th strike on the town, caused a preliminary death toll of 3, with 17 injured.

In Mar Mikhael - Chiyah, one person was killed and 3 others injured in an airstrike, while another airstrike on Bir Hassan killed one person. One person was also reported in the outskirts of Marwanieh.

Israeli airstrikes and shelling across South and the Bekaa

Israeli airstrikes and artillery shelling targeted multiple towns and villages across southern Lebanon and the Bekaa on Friday, March 6. In Nabatieh, an airstrike cut the road toward Nabatieh al-Fawqa and Kfar Tebnit, while a strike in Saida hit the Al-Maqassed building. Airstrikes on Shannouh south of Kfarchouba destroyed two homes and a park. Intense raids struck the southern suburbs of Beirut, including a violent double strike on Haret al-Jamous, and targeted Marwanieh outskirts.

Additional raids hit Al-Dweir, Boudai outskirts, a building in Al-Khadr, Khiyam, Beit Msheik farms west of Baalbek, Shaqra, a house in Al-Mansouri, and Sarifa. A mosque in the outskirts of Tarya and the Al-Kateeba Al-Ghaniyeh camp in Qawzah were also hit. Simultaneous airstrikes and intermittent shelling targeted Qawzah and Aita al-Shaab, while Yater and Aita al-Shaab were struck in two separate raids.

UNIFIL announces three peacekeepers injured inside their base in Qouzi

Statement issued by the United Nations Interim Force In Lebanon (UNIFIL) on Friday, February 6:

Amidst heavy firing this evening, three peacekeepers were injured inside their base in Al Qawzah, southwestern Lebanon. The most severely injured has been transferred to hospital in Beirut for treatment. The two others are being treated in a UNIFIL medical facility. A fire on the base has been extinguished.

UNIFIL will investigate the circumstances of this terrible event. It is unacceptable that peacekeepers performing Security Council-mandated tasks are targeted.

We strongly remind all actors of their obligations under international law to ensure the safety and security of UN personnel and properties at all times. Any attack on UNIFIL peacekeepers constitutes a grave violation of international humanitarian law and of the Security Council Resolution 1701 and may amount to a war crime.

Over 90 people killed in Israeli airstrikes and clashes across Lebanon

At least 19 people were killed in an airstrike on a building in Sir al-Gharbiyeh late at night on Saturday, March 7. In the early hours, 16 were killed and 35 were injured during a confrontation with Israeli commando forces in the town of Nabi Sheet.

An airstrike on Khirbet Selm resulted in 6 deaths and 5 injuries. A café in Jabal al-Batm, Tyre district, was struck, killing 3 people, while 2 more were killed in Kfarreman. Overall, the ongoing aggression has brought the total casualties in the conflict to at least 294 dead and 1,023 injured.

Israeli raids on Bint Jbeil, Nabatieh, and surrounding villages

Israeli airstrikes and artillery shelling targeted several towns and villages in southern Lebanon on Saturday, March 7, including the outskirts of Aita al-Shaab, Ramieh, and Qawzah.

Additional raids struck Sinai in the Nabatieh district, Ansar, Haddatha, and al-Jmeijmeh, while two airstrikes targeted Aadchit al-Qsair near a UNIFIL center. A vehicle was also targeted on the Msayleh road. Further strikes hit Habboush, and a series of raids targeted villages across the Nabatieh district as the Israeli army escalated its attacks on towns in the Nabatieh and Bint Jbeil areas later in the afternoon.

Tens of people killed and injured by Israeli airstrikes on Ain el-Helweh, Britel, and others

One person was killed and 10 were injured in an Israeli airstrike on Ain el-Helweh camp, while 4 people were killed and 10 others were injured in an airstrike on a hotel room in Rawshe on Sunday, March 8.

10 people were also killed and 6 others were injured in an airstrike on Sir, two killed and 6 injured in airstrike on Tebnin, 10 killed in airstrike on Tyre, and one shepherd killed in Alma al-Shaab.

Heavy Israeli airstrikes and shelling across southern Lebanon

Israeli airstrikes targeted the area between Harj Ali al-Taher and al-Dabsha near the Khardali road behind Douha Kfarreman, the outskirts of al-Qusayr toward Wadi al-Hujeir, Mayfadoun, Sahmar, Khiam, Qawzah, Beit Lif, Houmine al-Fawqa, Debbine, Zawtar, the outskirts of Brital, and the area between Mayfdoun and Choukine on Sunday, March 8.

Additional strikes targeted homes between the towns of Bedyas, Burj Rahal, al-Abbasiya, and Tayr Debba, while artillery shelling hit Taybeh. A series of raids also struck Jouaiya and the outskirts of Mazraat Meshref.

WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details
(e.g. which prison)



HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



WHAT:

Nature of the violation



WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
