## LEBANON

### [Two people killed and others injured after a family feud in Ain El Helwe](#)

A dispute occurred in Ain al-Hilweh camp in the Jabal al-Halib area, and gunfire killed two people and injured others on Monday, September 1.

The Palestinian National Security Forces announced that they were capable of establishing a ceasefire and handed over the killer to the Lebanese Army Intelligence.

### [Israeli drones attack Yaroun and Rab Thalathin](#)

An Israeli drone threw a grenade at a bulldozer in Yaroun with no injuries on Monday, September 1, and another drone targeted an excavator in Rab Thalathin.

### [State Security controls encroachments on electricity transformer stations](#)

**Statement issued by the General Directorate of State Security - Media, Guidance, and Public Relations Division on Monday, September 1:**

In continuation of its mission to monitor and control violations targeting public facilities, a patrol from the Bekaa Regional Directorate - West Bekaa Office arrested, on August 28, 2025, an individual for assaulting a public electricity transformer station that supplies a water well in the town of Kamed al-Loz. He had stolen power lines from the station in order to redistribute power to customers and gain illicit financial gain.

Legal measures have been taken against the suspect, based on the instructions of the competent judiciary.

## Israeli bombs and drones thrown near border villages

Two Israeli drones dropped two bombs at excavators in [Yaroun](#) and Mays al-Jabal on Tuesday, September 2, before one drone crashed in [Mays al-Jabal](#).

Simultaneously, an Israeli drone dropped a soundbomb in [Wazzani](#), and another drone threw leaflets in [Rab Thalatheen](#), Marjeyoun, with accusations of rehabilitating underground military infrastructure.

## Ministry of Youth and Sports freezes four paragliding clubs for breaching the Ministry's letter

The Minister of Youth and Sports Nora Bayrakdarian, issued a new decision to suspend the licenses of four paragliding associations for “their failure to comply with the contents of the Ministry’s letter” by not sending the names of the solo and double pilots accredited by it on Tuesday, September 2.

The associations are Northern Eagles Association, Cedars Paragliding Association, Lebanese Paragliding Association, and Delta Sports Association.

## Three officers arrested in Tripoli for bribery in customs case

Financial Prosecutor Maher Shaito arrested three officers from the Tripoli Port Customs Department as part of an ongoing investigation into an attempt to remove two trucks loaded with goods from the Tripoli port without paying fees on Tuesday, September 2.

The owner of the goods, the customs broker, and the trucks’ drivers were arrested by Shaito, according to the National News Agency.

## Four killed in Israeli airstrike on border villages; drones on Houla and Aitaroun

Heavy Israeli [airstrikes](#) were launched in border villages, killing four in the towns of Taybeh, Shebaa, Yater, and Al-Kharayeb in the South Governorate, in addition to at least 13 injuries on Wednesday, September 3.

Simultaneously, an Israeli drone dropped a soundbomb on citizens moving furniture from their homes in [Houla](#), and another bomb blew up a house on the outskirts of [Aitaroun](#).

## UNIFIL denounces Israeli attacks on personnel clearing roadblocks

### **Statement issued by UNIFIL on Wednesday, September 3:**

Yesterday morning, Israel Defense Forces (IDF) drones dropped four grenades close to UNIFIL peacekeepers working to clear roadblocks hindering access to a UN position close to the Blue Line.

This is one of the most serious attacks on UNIFIL personnel and assets since the cessation of hostilities agreement of last November. [...]

The IDF had been informed in advance of UNIFIL’s road clearance work in the area, southeast of the village of Marwahin. [...]

Any actions endangering UN peacekeepers and assets, and interference with their mandated tasks are unacceptable and a serious violation of Resolution 1701 and international law. It is the responsibility of the IDF to ensure safety and security of the peacekeepers performing Security Council-mandated tasks.

## Wounded person rescued after Israeli raid on Al-Kharayeb

According to the National News Agency, Israeli airstrikes on the outskirts of Al-Kharayeb and Kawthariyah Al-Raz wounded one person that was later rescued on Wednesday, September 3, and efforts are underway to extract two more people from under the rubble.

Simultaneously, an Israeli raid attacked a [valley](#) between Zrarieh and Ansar, and more Israeli shelling attacked a house on the outskirts of [Shebaa](#).

### Decomposed body found in Tabarja

A woman's [decomposed](#) body was found wrapped in a rug in a house in Kafr Yassin, Tabarja, Keserwan district on Thursday, September 4

### Israeli drones, leaflets, and evacuation orders in Khiam

An Israeli drone dropped leaflets inciting on certain companies with claims of "destabilizing security" over Khiam on Thursday, September 4.

Simultaneously, another Israeli [drone](#) fell over the town, and the Khiam municipality was informed to evacuate a [coffeeshop](#) in the center of town, after Israeli forces threatened to target it.

### Israeli combing operations and soundbombs in South villages

Israeli forces [combed](#) the outskirts of the Marjeyoun Plain and Khiam, and flew over Deir Qanoun al-Nahr and Maaroub on Thursday, September 4.

Simultaneously, an Israeli drone threw a sound bomb at a motorcycle in [Yaroun](#) that led to a fire in a field but no human injuries, and a prefabricated room was also targeted in [Aita al-Shaab](#).

### ISF arrests weapon smuggler from Syria to Lebanon

The Internal Security Forces captured an unknown individual smuggling warheads from Syrian territory into Lebanon through illegal crossings on Thursday, September 4, with a history of shooting and human smuggling cases.

### Israeli drone throws soundbomb in Yaroun; combing operation in Khiam

For a second time, an Israeli drone threw a soundbomb at a motorcycle in Yaron, with no injuries reported on Friday, September 5, according to the National News Agency.

Simultaneously, a heavy combing operation was conducted from Hamames Hill toward the outskirts of [Khiam](#).

## ISF arrests a drug dealer while attempting to escape

### **Statement issued by The Public Relations Division of the Internal Security Forces General Directorate on Friday, September 5:**

As part of the daily monitoring carried out by the Internal Security Forces to combat drug trafficking in various Lebanese regions, the Information Division received information regarding a person trafficking drugs on the Damour-Saadiyat-Jieh highway.

During his interrogation, he confessed to distributing drugs to a number of customers on the Damour-Saadiyat-Jieh highway, using the vehicle in which he was arrested. He added that he worked for a drug dealer, receiving the vehicle, the drugs intended for distribution, and a cell phone from one of the dealer's employees. [...]

### One killed and three injured in gold market gunfire in Saqiyat al-Janzir area

A dispute in the gold market in Saqiyat al-Janzir, Barbour, developed into a shooting, and led to the death of one person and three injuries on Saturday, September 6.

The killer was arrested by security forces, and other involved members were left under investigation

### Hotel seized by ISF after involvement in prostitution and drug trafficking

### **Statement issued by The Public Relations Division of the Internal Security Forces General Directorate on Saturday, September 6:**

As part of the ongoing efforts of the Internal Security Forces to combat crimes throughout Lebanon, particularly human trafficking, prosecuting prostitution networks, arresting their operators, and combating the phenomenon of young women working in this field,

Through monitoring and surveillance, the Anti-Trafficking in Persons and Morals Bureau of the Judicial Police Unit, with the support of the Central Anti-Narcotics Bureau of the same unit, was able to arrest 18 young women of various nationalities while engaging in prostitution in a hotel in the capital.[...]

### Large fire in forests in al-Dinniyyeh

A large fire broke out in the morning in the forests of Ayoun El Samak in Al-Dinniyyeh on Sunday, September 7.

After midnight, another massive fire also broke out in the Wadi al-Akhdar area, spreading to the forests of Jabal al-Rafi' and the surroundings of the town of Sajd.

### Israeli missile found in Yahmor al-Shaqif, and a bulldozer targeted in Tyre

An unexploded Israeli missile was found near a destroyed house in Yahmor al-Shaqif in Nabatieh on Sunday, September 7, and army officers were dispatched to dismantle it.

Simultaneously, an Israeli drone targeted a bulldozer in the town of Ma'aliyah, Tyre District.

# REPORTING A VIOLATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS TO CLDH

If you wish to report an incident that may potentially constitute a violation of human rights, kindly send an email to the following address: [violations@cldh-lebanon.org](mailto:violations@cldh-lebanon.org)

You can also report an incident anonymously through our [\*\*website\*\*](#).

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:

- **WHERE:** City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. what prison)
- **WHAT:** Nature of the violation
- **HOW:** A narrative description of what happened
- **WHEN:** Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)
- **TO WHOM:** Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.
- **WHO** is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
