### **One killed and eight injured in Israeli airstrikes on Ansariyeh and Qalila**

Israeli airstrikes attacked Ansariyeh in Saida district killing one person and injuring four others, while another airstrike on Qalila in Tyre district injured four other people on Monday, February 2, according to the Public Health Emergency Operations Center.

### **Dead woman's body found in al-Arida**

A Syrian woman's body was found in the Great River, Al-Arida, after Civil Defense teams carried out searches in the surrounding areas until Monday, February 2.

### **Heavy Israeli airstrikes and buildings attacked in border villages**

Israeli forces shelled the area between Salhani and Ramiya and targeted threatened buildings in Ain Qana and Kfar Tebnit with missiles on Monday, February 2.

Simultaneously, a car on the Zahrani-Sour highway was targeted, and three stun grenades dropped on Aita al-Shaab in the morning.

### **UNIFIL denounces a soundbomb thrown on patrol in Kfarkila**

UNIFIL announced that an Israeli soundbomb attacked one of its patrols on their routine activity in Kfarkila, with no injuries recorded on Tuesday, February 3.

The statement added that "peacekeepers assess that the drone belonged to the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) and crossed the Blue Line in violation of Security Council resolution 1701".

### **Gunfire at a house in al-Minieh**

A person fired a weapon towards a house at al-Balat neighborhood of al-Minieh, damaging the house with several bullets on Tuesday, February 3.

## **National Human Rights Commission denounces Israeli pesticides in southern Lebanon**

### **Statement issued by the National Human Rights Commission - Lebanon on Wednesday, February 4:**

The National Human Rights Commission, including the Committee for the Prevention of Torture, expresses its deep concern and strong condemnation of the continued spraying by Israeli forces of toxic chemical substances over agricultural lands and border areas in southern Lebanon, particularly the herbicide “glyphosate,” as part of repeated attacks that constitute a blatant violation of international humanitarian law, international human rights law, and international rules governing environmental protection during armed conflicts.

[...] The Commission considers that the repeated and systematic spraying of toxic chemicals on Lebanese territory cannot be justified as a collateral effect of the conflict. Rather, it falls within a deliberate policy that causes widespread and long-term environmental damage, strips local communities of their sources of livelihood, undermines food security, and imposes coercive living conditions that force residents to flee or prevent their safe and dignified return. Accordingly, the Commission views these acts as amounting to a crime of ecocide, given their sustained destructive impact on ecosystems and on fundamental human rights, including the right to life, the right to health, the right to food and water, and the right to a safe, healthy, and sustainable environment. ### **One person injured in personal feud in Ain al-Helweh camp**

A dispute in the Al-Bustan area inside the Ain al-Hilweh camp between two people escalated into an exchange of heavy gunfire, resulting in one person wounded on Wednesday, February 4.

### **Israeli bombings and soundbombs near Adaisseh and Kfarkila**

An Israeli soundbomb attacked Adaisseh and another regular bomb was thrown at al-Dhahira on Wednesday, February 4.

Simultaneously, Israeli artillery shelling targeted the Dis al-Khariba area between Mari and Rashaya al-Fakhar, and a violent explosion occurred in Kfarkila.

## **Heavy Israeli airstrikes and bombings in southern villages and in the Bekaa**

Israeli forces carried out a violent bombing between Markaba and Rabaa Thalathin, and artillery shelling in Yaroun, Ramiya and Beit Leef on Thursday, February 5.

Airstrikes have also attacked the outskirts of Sarira and Wadi Shbeil al-Qatrani, al-Waziyah in Jabal al-Rayhan, al-Mahmoudiyah in the south, and Hermel, Boudai and Flawi in Baalbek.

## **Financial corruption allegations in Saida leads to employees arrest**

**Statement issued by the General Directorate of State Security – Media, Guidance, and Public Relations Department on Thursday, February 5:**

As part of the General Directorate of State Security's efforts to combat corruption and safeguard public funds, and acting on instructions from the Financial Public Prosecutor, the South Regional Directorate of the General Directorate of State Security arrested the treasurer of Sidon Municipality (H.Q.) in connection with the disappearance of approximately one billion Lebanese pounds from the municipal treasury.

The head of the municipality's administrative and financial department (Z.D.) and seven other employees and municipal council members were released pending further investigation.

## **Migrant worker rescued after being trapped in Daher El Sawan**

**Statement issued by the Media and Public Relations Department of the General Directorate of Civil Defense on Friday, February 6:**

At 9:00 AM today, the General Directorate of Civil Defense operations room received a report of an Ethiopian domestic worker missing in a wooded area in Daher El Sawan.

Civil Defense teams conducted search operations and located her at a height of approximately six meters. Using ropes and specialized equipment, the team successfully rescued the worker and ensured her safety before transporting her to the hospital to receive necessary medical treatment.

## **Israeli soundbomb and shelling in Yaroun and Rmeish**

Two Israeli soundbombs exploded on the outskirts of Yaroun and Rmeish respectively, and artillery shells and gunfire targeted Yaroun as well on Friday, February 6.

### **Israeli gunfire attack Alma al-Shaab and Aita al-Shaab**

Israeli machine gunfire targeted the outskirts of Alma al-Shaab and Aita al-Shaab with no injuries reported on Saturday, February 7.

### **Multiple people under rubbles as building collapses in Tripoli**

For the second time, an old building collapsed in Tripoli with its inhabitants on Sunday, February 8. Three people were rescued, while the bodies of at least 13 people were found dead. Searches continue for the remaining people.

### **Death of a person injured by gunfire in Ablah**

According to the National News Agency, a young man was found dead with a gunshot wound to his shoulder, in his home in the vicinity of Farzel - Ablah.

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:



## WHERE:

City/village, governorate, additional details  
(e.g. which prison)



## HOW:

A narrative description of what happened



## TO WHOM:

Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.



## WHAT:

Nature of the violation



## WHEN:

Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)



## WHO

is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.
