LEBANON

Monday
5 May 2025

Four Israeli airstrikes on Tayr Harfa and missiles on Majdal Selem

Two Israeli missiles hit a landfill in Majdal Selem, and four airstrikes targeted [Tayr Harfa](#) on Monday, May 5. Three consecutive airstrikes were also thrown in an open area in [Aitaroun](#), Bint Jbeil district, and another airstrike hit Srifa. No casualties have been reported on any of the airstrikes.

Israeli raids on the eastern Lebanese-Syrian border

Israeli planes conducted a series of [airstrikes](#) on the barren area of the Lebanese-Syrian borders separating the Shaara neighborhood from the Syrian interior towards the eastern Lebanon mountain range.

Tuesday
6 May 2025

Person killed in open fire on a car in Akkar

An unidentified group of people opened fire at a van several times, and a Syrian woman was shot and killed on Tuesday, May 6 on Al-Samuniyah Road in Akkar. The car fled to an unknown destination, and investigations started.

One killed and three injured in Israeli airstrike on Kfarreman

An Israeli airstrike between Kfarreman and Nabatiyeh targeted a [car](#) and killed a citizen and injured three others on the night of Tuesday, May 6.

Wednesday
7 May 2025

Israeli airstrikes on Saida, Tyre, Kfarkila and Nabatieh: Deaths and Injuries

One person was killed in an Israeli airstrike on Saida on Wednesday, May 7, and another citizen was killed and three wounded after an airstrike targeted a car between Kfarreman and [Nabatieh](#).

Another Israeli plane threw two soundbombs at a car in [KfarKila](#), causing no injuries, and another attack on a [destroyed house](#) in Tyre resulted in one injury.

Ministry of Agriculture seizes 7 tons of smuggled agricultural products:

The General Directorate of Customs, in cooperation with the Ministry of Agriculture, seized large quantities of agricultural products smuggled into Lebanon. Violators will be fined with 2 million Lebanese pounds, which are equivalent to twice the value of the seized goods.

Thursday
8 May 2025

Israeli carpet bombing on Nabatieh kills one and injures eight

More than 15 Israeli airstrikes attacked the Nabatieh area on the morning of Thursday, May 8. The carpet bombing [killed](#) one citizen and wounded eight others.

Simultaneously, Israeli forces [opened fire](#) on two women in a car in Kfarkila, and they miraculously survived.

Israeli planes throws fake currency over Naqoura

An Israeli drone dropped [counterfeit currency](#) over the municipality of Naqoura that reads "Don't make a mistake, don't accept the yellow dollar."

Friday
9 May 2025

Israeli airstrike dropped a bomb on Majdal Zun and injured a citizen

A citizen was injured after an Israeli drone dropped a bomb on the town of Majdal Zun on Friday, May 9. Two soundbombs were dropped on a stone factory in [KfarKila](#) and on [Yaroun](#), with no injuries.

Saturday and Sunday

Israeli drone drops soundbombs over Khiyam

An Israeli drone dropped two soundbombs on a [bulldozer](#) in Wadi al-Asafir in Khiyam twice on Saturday, May 10, with no casualties recorded.

Israeli jets were also flying at a low altitude above villages in Tyre district, and over the Jezzine region.

Two citizens injured in Israeli Rubber Bullets

Israeli forces fired rubber bullets on a couple and [injured](#) them in Maroun El Rass in Bint Jbeil District on Sunday, May 11, while they were inspecting their destroyed home.

REPORTING A VIOLATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS TO CLDH

You can also report an incident anonymously through our [**website**](#).

When making a report, please ensure to include the following information:

- **WHERE:** City/village, governorate, additional details (e.g. what prison)
- **WHAT:** Nature of the violation
- **HOW:** A narrative description of what happened
- **WHEN:** Date of the episode (at least the year, if day and month are unknown)
- **TO WHOM:** Information regarding the victim (name, nationality, gender, date of birth, city of origin, phone number). Only share this information with the consent of the person.
- **WHO** is the person reporting (name, phone number) and how were they identified (e.g., victim him/herself, family member, eyewitness, journalist, humanitarian worker...)

The information referred will remain completely private. It will be fact-checked and registered into CLDH's internal system. No action will be undertaken without the explicit and written consent of the reporter.



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
